SO, NWAMAKA, JUST GETTING, NWAMAKA IS A RESTORATIVE ECONOMICS PRACTITIONER AND BRINGS SOLUTIONS ORIENTED APPROACH TO HER PROJECT MANAGEMENT CONSULTING.

NWAMAKA HAS BACKGROUND IN ORGANIZING, ELECTORAL CAMPAIGNS, POLICY, ADVOCACY, RACIAL, SOCIAL AND ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE ISSUES.

HER WORK, INCLUDES DEVELOPING STRATEGIES TO REDISTRIBUTE LAND, WEALTH, POWER IN THE FIELD OF PHILANTHROPY, AND ALIGN PRACTICES WITH GRASSROOTS LEADERSHIP AND COMMUNITIES' VISION FOR COOPERATIVE AND REGENERATIVE ECONOMY.

WE REALLY ARE HONORED TO BE COPRESENTING WITH MY DEAR FRIEND, JENNIFER NEAR.

YES, MY NAME IS NWAMAKA

AGBO, OUT OF OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA.

I OPERATE AS INDEPENDENT CONSULTANT AND PROJECT MANAGEMENT SUPPORT TO KPHAOUP TEE OWNED AND GOVERNED PROJECT AS WELL AS ALSO PROVIDING STRATEGIC ADVICE TO PHILANTHROPIES, INVESTORS AND DONORS.

AND, I THINK BY TERMS OF MYSELF-INTRODUCTION I JUST WANT TO FOR EVERYBODY LISTENING IN ON OUR CONVERSATION TODAY THAT INITIALLY, WE WERE INVITED TO PARTICIPATE WE HAD PLANNED A VERY DIFFERENT PROGRAM.

AND JUST KIND OF GIVEN AS A STATE OF THE WORLD, JENNIFER AND I, ADRIANA, AND ANNIE THOUGHT IT WOULD BE HELPFUL TO RETHINK OUR CONVERSATION IN THE CONTEXT OF WHAT IS HAPPENING WITH THE BLACK LIVES MATTER UPRISING ACROSS THE COUNTRY AND WORLD.

SO WE ARE GOING TO HAVE A LOOSELY HELD CONVERSATION A BIT MORE INFORMAL TODAY, BUT HOPE THAT FOLKS CAN KIND OF HOLD US IN HAVING, AN HONEST AND INCOMPLETE CONVERSATION AS YOU PROCESS SOME OF THE WORLD'S EVENTS TOGETHER IN THE CONTEXT OF WHAT IT MEANS TO GIVE AND SUPPORT.

WOULD LOVE TO PASS IT OFF TO JEN.

>> JENNIFER NEAR: THANKS, NWAMAKA.

THANK YOU FOR INVITING ME.

SUCH AN HONOR TO COPRESENT WITH NWAMAKA, DEAR FRIEND AND COLLEAGUE IN THE WORK.

YEAH, THANKS, ANNIE, ADRIANA FOR MAKING SPACE FOR THE CONVERSATION A AGAIN, I AM JENNIFER NEAR. PRONOUNS ARE SHE/HER, I LIVE IN SOUTHEAST NEW HAMPSHIRE. AND I WORK MOSTLY AS PROGRAM DIRECTOR FOR THE PROGRAM THAT ANNIE MENTIONED BUT ALSO DO WORK ON THE SIDE AS A CONSULTANT, SUPPORTING INFORMAL FUNDER ORGANIZING AND DONOR ORGANIZING PROJECTS, SUPPORTING INSTITUTIONS AND INDIVIDUALS AND MOVING THEIR RESOURCES IN ALIGNED WAYS AND ALSO IN JUST SUPPORTING GRASSROOTS EFFORTS IN MY OWN COMMUNITY AS RESOURCE MOBILIZER AND AS AN ORGANIZER. YEAH, I APPRECIATE NWAMAKA, YOU KIND OF REFRAMING US, IT IS INTERESTING IN THIS MOMENT BECAUSE EVERYTHING THAT WE WOULD HAVE PRESENTED ON AND TALKED ABOUT IS STILL TRUE. AND, YET, THE LEVEL OF CRISIS REQUIRES US TO ENTER INTO THE CONVERSATION IN A DIFFERENT PLACE.

SO, ONE OF THE THINGS THAT WE REALLY LEAN INTO IN THIS WORK AND HOW WE SHOW UP IN RELATIONSHIP TO COMMUNITIES AND THE MOVEMENTS WE WORK IS TO BE HIGHLY ADAPTIVE, AND SUPPORTIVE, AS, AS THINGS SHIFT AND EVOLVE.

THAT'S A REALLY -- KIND OF KEY PART I THINK OF BEING IN RIGHT RELATIONSHIP AND PRACTICE.

SO I THINK BEFORE WE, WE FULLY DIVE INTO MORE OF THE INFORMAL CONTENT THAT WE HAVE SHIFTED, WE WERE JUST GOING TO TACK A MINUTE, JUST TO SAY A LITTLE BIT ABOUT WHAT IS GOING ON IN OUR COMMUNITIES.

BECAUSE THAT JUST FEELS REALLY PRESENT RIGHT NOW.

SO I AM HAPPY TO JUST START.

THEN MAYBE, NWAMAKA, CAN PASS IT BACK TO YOU.

AND THEN, ANNIE, I KNOW YOU WERE GOING TO SHARE A LITTLE BIT ABOUT WHAT IS GOING ON AND ALSO YOUR EXPERIENCE AROUND GIVING AND ALSO LIKE WHAT YOU ARE THINKING ABOUT IN TERMS OF YOUR OWN GIVING IN THIS MOMENT.

YOU KNOW, I WOULD SAY --

IN MY COMMUNITY -- THINGS FEEL REALLY STRANGE.

AND HEARTBREAKING.

IT IS STRANGE ON THE ONE HAND BECAUSE OF THE LEVEL OF STATE VIOLENCE HERE ISN'T AS EXTREME, ORGANIZED, SANCTIONED,

POLICE VIOLENCE.

AT THE SAME TIME, WE HAVE A VERY STRONG, RIGHT-WING, ARMED MILITIA PRESENCE IN MY COMMUNITY.

SO, ONE OF THE WAYS I HAVE BEEN SHOWING UP IS AS A DE-ESCALATOR, PEACEKEEPER, AS SOME OF THE ACTIONS HERE. AND FOLKS WHO ARE ORGANIZING IN SUPPORT OF BLACK LIVES. ARE BEING SURVEILLED.

WE ARE BEING VIDEOTAPED.

WE ARE BEING PHOTOGRAPHED.

YOU KNOW, THERE IS A LEVEL OF INTIMIDATION.

AND FOLKS, YOU KNOW HERE, AN OPEN CARRY SO WE ARE VERY VISIBLY ARMED, WE HAD SOMEBODY SHOW UP TO, MARCH ON SATURDAY.

AND JUST, STAND SILENTLY IN THE CORNER, HOLDING A CONFEDERATE FLAG.

SO, IT FEELS REALLY HOSTILE.

AND SCARY.

AND, WE KNOW THAT THEIR VISION FOR WHAT COMES ON THE OTHER SIDE OF THIS IS DRAMATICALLY DIFFERENT THAN THE VISION THAT WE HOLD AROUND EQUITY AND JUSTICE.

AND THEY'RE ORGANIZED AND PRESENT.

SO THAT IS WHAT MY COMMUNITY FEELS LIKE RIGHT NOW.

NWAMAKA, ANYTHING YOU WANT TO SHARE?

>> NWAMAKA AGBO: I THINK WHAT I WOULD ADD, FROM PERSPECTIVE AS A BLACK WOMAN DOING THIS WORK IS, JUST WANT TO ACKNOWLEDGE THAT COLLECTIVELY AROUND THE WORLD WE HAVE ALREADY BEEN SUSTAINING A LEVEL OF STRESS AND TRAUMA GIVEN THE GLOBAL PANDEMIC.

SO WHEN THE UPRISING KIND OF BROKE, THERE WAS A WAY IN WHICH IT WAS A -- A REINJURY -- OPENED UP AN OLD WOUND PARTICULARLY FOR BLACK COMMUNITIES THAT HAVE HAD TO WITNESS THIS TYPE OF ATTACK AND TRAUMA OVER AND OVER AGAIN.

AND SO, I WOULD SAY IN MY -- PERSONAL LIFE, WATCHING A LOT OF FRIENDS AND COLLEAGUES STRUGGLE WITH MENTAL HEALTH STABILITY.

WATCHING PEOPLE KIND OF REACH THEIR SNAPPING POINT. OR THEIR BREAKING POINT.

JUST KIND OF, BEING THAT THEY HAVE ALREADY BEEN UNDER DURESS, THIS IS ONE MORE THING.

AND THEN I THINK, COLLECTIVELY, IN OAKLAND, IT IS VERY DIFFERENT, GLAD WE ARE TALKING ABOUT THIS, JEN, BECAUSE OAKLAND HAS A HISTORY OF DIRECT ACTION AND POLITICAL ENGAGEMENT AND SO THERE IS A WAY IN WHICH IT SPEAKS TO THE NEEDS AND A LOT OF THE -- FRUSTRATION THAT PEOPLE HAVE BEEN HOLDING ON TO.

WITHIN THEIR HOMES.

AS WE HAVE KIND OF WATCHED, OUR FEDERAL GOVERNMENT --COMPLETELY MESS UP THE HANDLING OF THE -- COVID-19 AND SO, THERE IS A WAY IN WHICH PEOPLE TAKING TO THE STREETS, IS FINALLY ALLOWING PEOPLE TO RELEASE AND PROCESS A LOT OF THE ANGER AND FRUSTRATION.

AND, I THINK ALSO BECAUSE WE HAVE A HISTORY OF DIRECT ACTION AND POLITICAL ENGAGEMENT, THE PEOPLE ARE ALSO BRACING THEMSELVES FOR -- FOR THE OPPRESSION THAT COMES AS WELL.

SO IT IS JUST INTERESTING TO KIND OF REFLECT ON THE WAY THAT PEOPLE ARE TAKING ON POLITICAL ACTIVITY.

IN OAKLAND I KNOW WE HAVE A CURFEW IN EFFECT AT 8:00 P.M. THERE IS A -- A CONCERTED EFFORT TO ACTUALLY STAY OUT PAST CURFEW AS A WAY OF BEING ABLE TO DEFEND OUR RIGHTS TO PROTEST.

AND ALSO BRACING OURSELVES FOR WHAT IT MEANS FOR FOLKS TO DEFY CURFEW, DEFY, A STATE-SANCTIONED LIMITATION ON PROTEST.

WHAT THAT MEANS.

SO I THINK -- IT'S INTERESTING TO SEE FROM THE EAST COAST TO THE WEST COAST, URBAN TO RURAL, HOW DIFFERENT COMMUNITIES ARE RESPONDING IN THE MOMENT, CAPACITIES TO ENGAGE IN DIFFERENT WAYS OR SEE THE MOMENT VISUALIZED, DIFFERENT TENSIONS OF THE SAME CONFLICT, CONVERSATION, STRUGGLE THAT WE ARE COLLECTIVELY HAPPENING. AND WE ALSO KNOW THAT WE HAVE, ANNIE, AND IN WASHINGTON, D.C. THAT HAS A VERY PARTICULAR POLITICAL CONTEXT AND SAW NATIONALLY WHAT IS HAPPENING IN D.C. AND THIS IS ALSO A PLACE WHERE YOU IN YOUR FAMILY IS COMMITTED TO, TO GIVING. SO I WOULD LOVE FOR YOU TO MAYBE SET US UP IN THE CONTEXT OF SHARING A BIT MORE ABOUT WHAT YOU ARE EXPERIENCING. AND, THE HISTORY, HOW YOU'RE GIVING STORY HAS KIND OF LENT ITSELF TO THIS MOMENT.

>> ANNIE MAHON: THANK YOU, YES.

HAPPY TO SHARE.

I DON'T WANT TO TACK TOO MUCH TIME AWAY FROM Y'ALL.

I DON'T WANT TO TAKE TOO MUCH TIME AWAY FROM Y'ALL.

YES, HERE IN D.C. IT HAS BEEN INTERESTING.

I AM SURE YOU HAVE READ A LOT ABOUT IT.

BUT FOR ONE THING THE CURFEW TONIGHT HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO 11:00.

A LITTLE BIT OF A BACK AND FORTH WITH OUR MAYOR AND THE PRESIDENT ALMOST.

KIND OF, A FUNNY LITTLE STRUGGLE HAPPENING THERE. THERE ARE A LOT OF PEOPLE OUT, EVERY DAY, MORE PEOPLE, GETTING MORE PEACEFUL SEEMINGLY.

SO, I THINK SATURDAY IS SUPPOSED TO BE A BIG DAY HERE, VERY BIG DAY IN WASHINGTON.

SO, WE SHALL SEE.

BUT, ON MY STORY OF GIVING, WE STARTED OUT --

WE STARTED MAKING, MY HUSBAND STARTED MAKING EXTRA MONEY.

WE WANTED TO BE ABLE TO GIVE ATE WAY.

BECAUSE I, I DIDN'T GROW UP WITH A TON OF MONEY.

SO I, REALLY DIDN'T LIKE THIS IDEA OF HAVING, HOARDING MONEY OR HAVING EXTRA MONEY.

SO WE STARTED OUT JUST SORT OF IN THE USUAL WAY GIVING ATE WAY.

WE CREATED THIS FAMILY FOUNDATION.

BUT WE WERE GIVING KIND OF TO -- SERVICE, GIVING TO WHATEVER PEOPLE FELT LIKE GIVING TO.

YOU KNOW IT WAS GOOD.

A GOOD BEGINNING.

WE STARTED REALLY GETTING THIS HABIT OF GIVING.

AND LOOKING FOR PLACES TO GIVE.

AND AFTER A FEW YEARS, OUR DAUGHTER HANNAH, DID SOME WORK WITH RESOURCE GENERATION WHICH IS AN AMAZING ORGANIZATION FOR YOUNG PEOPLE WITH WEALTH WHO ARE LOOKING TO USE THAT WEALTH FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE CAUSES.

AND SHE CAME BACK AND SUGGESTED THAT WE START THINKING DIFFERENTLY HOW WE GIVE MONEY.

AND ONE OF THE WAYS THAT WE HAVE SHIFTED OUR THINKING IS HOW DO WE USE THIS MONEY INSTEAD OF JUST TO KEEP -- YOU KNOW, HELPING PEOPLE, WHICH IS NOT A BAD THING, BUT SO MANY PEOPLE ARE HELPING IN THIS SERVICE INDUSTRY.

SO MANY PEOPLE GIVE TO HOSPITALS.

SO MANY PEOPLE GIVE TO ORGANIZATIONS, THAT ARE DOING ON THE GROUND SERVICE WORK, HOMELESSNESS, THINGS LIKE THAT. BUT SHE SAID THAT THERE ARE NOT MANY PEOPLE GIVING TO REALLY SHIFT THE POWER DYNAMIC IN THE WORLD.

TO SHIFT THE SYSTEMS.

AND SO SHE REALLY EDUCATED ME ON THIS.

AND BROUGHT IN OTHER PEOPLE WHO HAVE EDUCATE ON THIS.

SO IN ALIGNMENT WITH MY MINDFULNESS PRACTICE AND WHAT I CARE ABOUT IN THE WORLD.

BECAUSE I DON'T WANT TO ALWAYS BE IN POSSESSION OF HAVING MONEY AND GIVING MONEY.

I DON'T WANT THAT.

THAT'S NOT THE WORLD THAT I WANT TO LIVE IN.

I WANT TO LIVE IN A WORLD WHERE, EVERYBODY HAS WHAT THEY NEED.

AND THAT IT IS NOT ALWAYS THE SAME PEOPLE WHO ARE HANDING OUT TO THE SAME OTHER PEOPLE.

BUT THAT WE ARE SHIFTING THE DYNAMIC IN SUCH A WAY THAT EVERYBODY CAN HAVE WHAT THEY NEED AND, EVERYBODY CAN GIVE AND RECEIVE. SO, BY USING THE RESOURCES THAT WE HAVE TO GIVE TO ORGANIZATIONS THAT ARE ON THE GROUND, DOING THE WORK, LED BY THE PEOPLE DOING THE WORK.

ORGANIZING PEOPLE TO DEVELOP MORE POWER FOR -- FRONT LINE COMMUNITIES.

THEN I FEEL LIKE WE ARE MAKING THAT DIFFERENCE.

WE ARE HAVING THE IMPACT WHERE WE ARE SHIFTING SOME OF THE POWER AND MONEY THAT WE HAVE TO -- TO OTHER GROUPS OF PEOPLE, OTHER COMMUNITIES.

SO FOR ME IT WAS FIRRIST ALEARNING ABOUT WHERE TO PUT THE MONEY.

SO, OKAY, HERE IS WHERE WE ARE GOING TO SHIFT THE MONEY. THEN IT WAS LEARNING ABOUT HOW DO WE ACTUALLY START LETTING GO OF THE DECISION MAKING AROUND THE MONEY EVEN. LIKE HOW DO WE GIVE UP THE POWER THAT WE HAVE. SO, YEAH, SO IT HAS BEEN A KIND OF STEP BY STEP LEARNING. AND SO WE HAVE BEEN -- OVER THIS LAST YEAR, FOUNDATION HAS DECIDED TO GIVE --

TO GIVE TO -- TO A LARGER UMBRELLA ORGANIZATION.

TO GIVE MORE TO AN UMBRELLA ORGANIZATION.

THAT THEN WILL CHOOSE WHICH OF THE SMALLER ORGANIZATIONS WILL GET THE MONEY.

SO WE ARE GIVING A LARGER AMOUNT TO MOVEMENT FOR BLACK LIVES.

WITHIN THAT, THEY'RE CHOOSING WHICH OF THE -- LOCAL ORGANIZATIONS NEED IT.

AND WILL GET IT.

SO EVEN THOUGH THERE IS NO WAY TO FULLY GIVE UP THE DECISION MAKING POWER.

WE ARE TRYING TO EDGE CLOSER TO THAT SO.

THAT HAS BEEN OUR PROCESS.

I AM SO GRATEFUL TO HANNAH, TO, JUSTICE FUNDERS, TO LUKE, NEWTON, OUR CONSULTANT, TO AWFUL THE PEOPLE, WHO HAVE HELPED US TO MAKE THIS PROGRESS.

BECAUSE, I FEEL LIKE THIS IS ONE OF THE KEY -- KEY PIECES OF SHIFTING THE WORLD.

IS TO SHIFT THIS POWER AND MONEY IN WAYS THAT -- THAT REALLY CAN MAKE A BIG DIFFERENCE.

I AM VERY PASSIONATE ABOUT IT AS YOU CAN. THANK YOU FOR GIVING ME A MOMENT TO SHARE.

WHAT GYP AND I PLANNED.

ROUGHLY, NEXT TEN MINUTES.

WE ARE BOTH GOING TO TAKE AN OPPORTUNITY TO RESPOND TO, TWO

REFLECTION QUESTIONS THAT WE HAVE BEEN SITTING WITH.

I AM GOING TO TRY TO DROP IT IN THE CHAT BOX IF I CAN GET MY THING TO WORK IN CASE -- I DON'T KNOW WHY -- OKAY.

I WILL DEAL WITH IT LATER.

TWO REFLECTION QUESTIONS.

AND THANKS, JEN.

AND I WOULD, OFFER THAT -- ONCE AGAIN, LIKE THESE ARE INCOMPLETE THOUGHTS.

AS WE ARE KIND OF STILL FORMING OUR OWN ANALYSIS AROUND THE MOMENT AND HUH TO CONNECT IT TO GIVING.

BUT, YOU ALL ARE AS YOU ARE LISTENING TO US SHARE SOME OF OUR REFLECTIONS TAKE IN THESE REFLECTION QUESTIONS FOR YOURSELF.

SO THE FIRST QUESTION IS -- YOU KNOW, PEOPLE TO SHARE HOW YOU ARE DOING AND WHAT ARE YOU REFLECTING ON IN THIS MOMENT?

I WOULD SAY THAT -- FOR ME, IN TERMS OF HOW I AM DOING. I THINK, THIS IS A REALLY DIFFICULT MOMENT.

IT IS HARD TO STAY PRESENT AND ACTIVE IN THE WORK. PARTICULARLY, WANTING TO BE OUT ON THE STREETS.

I WOULD SAY THIS IS -- IT FEELS REALLY HARD TO HAVE TO JUSTIFY.

YOUR HUMANITY AND RIGHT TO LIVE WITH DIGNITY.

SO, I HAVE BEEN REALLY SITTING WITH --

IN A MATTER OF A FEW MONTHS, FROM COVID-19 TO -- TO THE UPRISINGS THAT HAVE BEEN HAPPENING.

WE HAVE SEEN BLACK PEOPLE BE DISPROPORTIONATELY IMPACT ON BOTH ENDS.

COVID-19 HELPS TO EXPOSE WEAKNESS AND FAILURE IN PUBLIC HEALTH SYSTEM AND POLICE BRUTALITY EXPOSES FAILURES OF OUR JUSTICE SYSTEM AND INQUALITY OF THE JUSTICE SYSTEM. FOR ME AND JEN, WE SPEND A LOT OF TIME, REALLY TALKING TO, THE PLANS WE ARE PART OF, THE WEALTH GAP. AND THE TWO MOMENTS IN HISTORY HAVE HELPED TO VISIBLIZE, WHILE THE RACIAL -- CHARACTERIZATION OF DISPARITY WHOSE HAS ACCESS TO CAPITAL AND INCOME, IT DOESN'T REALLY FULLY CAPTURE THE DEPTH OF THE DISPARITIES WITHIN THE COMMUNITIES.

AND PARTICULARLY, I THINK THAT THE DIVIDE WE ARE LOOKING AT IS HEALTH AND WELL BEING DIVIDE.

AND THIS UNFORTUNATELY IS A PLACE WHERE WE SEE BLACK PEOPLE ON THE LOSING END OF ALL OF IT.

SO THEN WE HAVE --

A COUNTRY, SOCIETY, WHERE IT IS ALMOST TABOO TO TALK ABUT

RACE.

AND NOW WE SEE THAT RACE IS BUBBLED UP IN THE FOREFRONT IN THE WAY THAT WE CAN'T DENY.

I THINK THAT IS, IN THE PLACE WHERE'S WE HAVE BEEN FORCED TOO OFF THE CONVERSATION THAT WE HAVE BEEN SHYING AWAY FROM.

I THINK THE OTHER THING THAT HAS BEEN COMING UP.

JEN AND I HAVE TALKED ABOUT THIS.

A LITTLE BIT, CHATTED WITH MY HUSBAND ABOUT THIS THE OTHER DAY.

IS THAT THERE IS A NARRATIVE THAT IS ALSO HAPPENING --ACROSS THE MEDIA, AROUND, REALLY WANTING TO PROTECT PROPERTY.

AND REALLY WANTING -- REALLY SAYING THE ROLE OF THE POLICE IS TO ACTUALLY PROTECT PROPERTY.

AND, THIS IS EXTREMELY PAINFUL FOR -- FOR A PEOPLE. WHERE -- THE DEFENDANTS, I SHOULD, I AM, NIGERIAN AMERICAN, MY PARENTS CAME TO THE STATES IN '79.

I WOULD SAY THAT BY THE -- BY THE, THE BLESSINGS THAT I HAVE TO WALK ON THIS EARTH IN A BLACK SKIN I OFTEN TIMES WILL EXPERIENCE THE SAME LEVELS OF, MICROAGGRESSIONS, AND FEAR FOR MY BROTHERS LIVES AND THEIR SAFETY IN THE SAME WAY.

AND SO, THE HISTORY OF SLAVERY WHILE NOT DIRECTLY IN MY LINEAGE IS SOMETHING THAT I IDENTIFY GIVEN MY EXPERIENCE IN THE COUNTRY IN A BLACK BODY.

AND SO, WHEN WE THINK ABOUT --

THE FACT THAT WE HAVE A POLICE FORCE THAT IS REALLY --BEING PUSHED ON TO PROTECT PROPERTY.

AT ONE POINT, THE HISTORY OF OUR COUNTRY IS ONE IN WHICH BLACK PEOPLE -- PEOPLE FROM AFRICA, REGARDED AS CHATTLE SLAVERY, RIGHT.

WE ARE REGARDED AS PROPERTY.

AND NOW, IN A MOMENT WHERE WE SEE PEOPLE BEING MURDERED IN THE STREETS, WE ARE -- WE ARE, SOME PEOPLE, THE NARRATIVE FOR SOME COMMUNITIES IS THAT, THERE ITS MORE OF A -- VALUE ON THAT PROPERTY.

THAN THERE IS ON BLACK LIVES.

AND SO, WHILE, 400 YEARS AGO, WE MAYBE REGARDED AS PROPERTY.

IN 2020, WE HAVE A NARRATIVE NOW, WE ARE SEEN LESS THAN VALUABLE AS PROPERTY.

SO THAT'S ALSO EXTREMELY PAINFUL.

AND, REALLY WANTING PEOPLE TO REALLY GRAPPLE WITH THE FACT

THAT, THE WAY THAT WE DEVELOPED OUR -- COUNTRY KIND OF THE HISTORY, OF OUR ECONOMY -- IS ONE IN WHICH WE HAVE ALWAYS KIND OF PRIVILEGED CAPITAL.

PROFIT.

PROPERTY.

OVER PEOPLE.

AND, THE WAYS THAT WE ALLOW FOR THE PROTECTION OF PRIVATE PROPERTY.

STAND UP AGAINST CORPORATIONS POLLUTING WATER AND SYSTEMS AND EXTRACTING NATURAL RESOURCES FROM THE GROUND.

AND HANNAH REALLY LIFTING UP THE NEED TO HAVE A DEEP --DEEP INVESTIGATION ABOUT WHERE POWER SITS AND HOW POWER, WHO GETS TO HOLD POWER AND CLAIM IT.

EXERCISE IT.

IS ALSO REALLY SHAPING THE CONVERSATION.

AND, NOT THE CONVERSATION JUST IN THE MOMENT, BUT HAS KIND OF BEEN A SUBTONE IN HOW WE DEVELOPED OUR SOCIETY AS WELL. AND SO --

FOR ME, I AM REALLY ADVISING PEOPLE THAT I WORK WITH, AND IN COMMUNITY WITH, TO START TAKING, TAKING A DEEPER LOOK. TOOK OUR ECON CLASS ALONGSIDE THE GOVERNMENT CLASS. AND THAT'S BECAUSE THE ROLE OF GOVERNMENT, IDEALLY, RIGHT IS TO KIND OF INTERVENE AND MANAGE MARKET FORCES AND MANAGE THE ECONOMY SO THAT WE PROTECT FOR THE GOOD OF ALL PEOPLE. BUT, SINCE WE HAVE AN ECONOMIC SYSTEM, ONE THAT IS CAPITALISM IT MEANS THAT WE CONTINUE TO PRIVILEGE PROFIT OVER PEOPLE AND THE PLANET.

AND I WOULD ACTUALLY SAY THAT RIGHT NOW, WE SEE --CAPITALISM ALSO REALLY SHAPING OUR DEMOCRACY, OUR FORM OF GOVERNMENT.

AND I ACTUALLY PULLED AWAY FROM EVEN CALLING IT DEMOCRACY ANY MORE TO REFERRING IT AS CORPORATE-OCRACY, DEFEND HIGH-RISE BUILDINGS, BIG CORPORATIONS MAKE IT POSSIBLE FOR AMAZON TO GO WITHOUT PAYING TAXES BUT THEN INCARCERATE AND MURDER PEOPLE THAT ARE TRYING TO MANAGE SOME TYPE OF DIGNIFIED LIVING FOR THEMSELVES AND THEIR COMMUNITIES. THOSE ARE THE DISPARITIES THAT WE NEED TO BE AWARE OF. AND THOSEINTERCONNECTION, GERRYMANDERING, VOTER SUPPRESSION IS CONNECTED WITH HEALTH SYSTEM AND EDUCATION SYSTEM AND INABILITY FOR PEOPLE TO HAVE RESOURCES THEY NEED TO TACK CARE OF THEMSELVES.

THESE UPRISINGS, IF ANYTHING, I WOULD LIKEN THEM TO -- KIND OF THE SIMMER THAT SITS IN BLACK PEOPLE ON A DAY-TO-DAY BASIS AND HAS ACTUALLY JUST REACHED A BOILING POINT. AND WE ARE ACTUALLY JUST TAKING THE LID OFF OF IT. BUT WHAT WE ARE EXPERIENCING IN THE STREETS NOW IS ACTUALLY, SOMETHING THAT MANY OF US HAVE EXPERIENCED REGULARLY.

AND, BECAUSE WE HAVE DENIED TO TAKE A CLOSE LOOK AT IT, WE HAVE BEEN FORCED TO ACTUALLY PUT IT IN FRONT OF PEOPLE. IN A WAY THAT IS UNDENIABLE.

AND I THINK, I WILL KIND OF LOOK CLOSE AND, GET OFF MY SOAPBOX AND HAND IT OFF TO JEN.

BEFORE WE GO TO THE NEXT QUESTION.

THERE WAS A QUOTE THAT WE SHARED WITH ANNIE AND THE COHORT. WHEN WE WERE TAKING A CLOSE LOOK AT RACISM.

AND CAP RALISM.

AND I THINK -- A LOT OF THAT, REPORTING FROM THE 1619 SERIES BY "THE NEW YORK TIMES" WRITTEN ARTICLES AND PODCASTS, BY NICOLE HAND, INTO AND THEN THE WORK OF, THE BOOK, HOW TO BE ANTIRACIST, KENNEDY SUMS IT UP BEAUTIFULLY WHEN HE SAYS YOU CAN'T BE ANTIRACIST AND BELIEVE IN CAPITALISM.

AND SO, OUR ABILITY TO -- REALLY UNDERSTAND HOW POLITICAL STRUGGLE SITS WITHIN THAT INTERSECTION OFADDRESSING RACISM AND ADDRESSING CAPITALISM AND WHY WE FEEL THE NEED TO HAVE DIRECTION ACTION AND CIVIL UNREST AND PROTEST AS A PART OF OUR OVERALL TOOLBOX AND STRATEGIES FOR HOW TOY CRATE CHANGE.

ANYWHERE FROM POLICY ADVOCACY TO ELECTORAL ORGANIZING, ALSO NEEDS TO BE ABLE TO HAVE ROOM FOR CIVIL DISOBEDIENCE AND DIRECT ACTION.

AND, UNFORTUNATELY, WHILE WE WANT TO -- WHY WE MAY KIND OF HAVE A HARD TIME ENGAGING IN THE CONVERSATION ABOUT VIOLENCE.

I THINK OUR COUNTRY HAS BEEN A VIOLENT COUNTRY.

AND THAT'S WHY -- UNFORTUNATELY, WE DO SEE IT AS PART OF --OF THE STRUGGLE.

WHETHER WE INVITE IT OR NOT.

AND IT IS THERE, BECAUSE THAT IS THE TONE THAT HAS BEEN SET.

BY THE FOUNDING OF THE UNITED STATES.

SO, JEN WOULD LOVE TO KIND OF INVITE YOU TO THIS QUESTION TO SIT WITH, YOU KNOW, LET US KNOW HOW YOU ARE DOING.

AND WHAT ARE YOU REFLECTION ON IN THE MOMENT.

WHAT'S COMING UP FOR YOU?

>> JENNIFER NEAR: THANK YOU, NWAMAKA.

I THINK I JUST WANT TO SHARE AN INVITATION THAT SOMEBODY

ONCE SHARED WITH ME.

LIKE IN THIS WORK.

WITH EVERYONE.

JUST TO SAY, NWAMAKA AND I ARE GOING TO DO THIS LITTLE BIT OF RIFFING, WHICH IS WHAT THE HECK? YOU KNOW.

WE ARE GOING TO DO THIS LITTLE BIT OF RIFFING AND ALSO GOING TO BARAK YOU THE OUT INTO GROUPS SO THAT YOU ALL CAN KIND OF SHARE.

LIKE WHAT IS COMING UP FOR YOU IN THE MOMENT.

HOW YOU ARE MAKING SENSE OF THINGS.

HOW THAT COULD INFORM THE WAY YOU GIVE AND THE RESOURCES. BUT, JUST ONE THING, AS SOMEBODY WHO IDENTIFIES AS WHITE. I COME FROM LIKE MORE OF A RURAL -- WORKING AND MIDDLE-CLASS BACKGROUND.

BUT, YOU KNOW, SOMEBODY WHO HAS REALLY, TRIED TO, MOVE IN THIS WORK.

AN, AND GROW.

OVER THE LAST SEVERAL YEARS.

DIDN'T COME IN WITH AS MUCH POLITICAL ANALYSIS, OR DIDN'T REALLY HAVE LANGUAGE AROUND, YOU KNOW, ANTICAPITALISM. AND EVEN RACISM. EARLIER ON, WHEN I ENTERED INTO THIS WORK, THERE IS A WAY IN WHICH THERE IS JUST SO MUCH UNDOING AND UNLEARNING AND SO ONE OF THE THINGS THAT SOMEBODY ONCE SAID TO ME WAS, NOTICE WHEN LIKE YOUR CHEST GETS TIGHT OR YOU FEEL RESISTANCE IN YOUR BODY, BECAUSE SOME TIMES BEFORE WE CAN INTELLECTUALLY PROCESS WHAT PEOPLE ARE SAYING, IT MIGHT BE LIKE, LIKE, IN SOME WAY --

LIKE, WE WANT TO, EXPRESS SOME SORT OF DEFENSE TO IT OR CONTRADICTION TO IT.

AND COMING UP IN OUR BODY.

IT IS JUST LIKE SO MANY OF THE THINGS WE HAVE BEEN CONDITIONED AROUND.

I JUST IN SRAOEULT FOLKS TO BE PRESENT.

LIKE IF YOU FEEL ANY KIND OF WAY ABOUT ANYTHING WE ARE SAYING.

BECAUSE THAT'S JUST REAL.

WE HAVE BEEN CONDITIONED TO RESPOND, TO NOT TALK ABOUT THE THINGS.

TO HAVE CERTAIN, PHYSIOLOGICAL RESPONSES IN OUR BODIES. JUST WANT TO INVITE THAT.

WHAT IS COMING UP FOR ME?

THAT I CAN SAY, IN ADDITION TO EVERYTHING, THE MESSAGE THAT

I SHARED.

YOU KNOW, I THINK I AM REFLECTING A LOT ABOUT HISTORY. I AM REFLECTING A LOT ABOUT HOW I HAVE COME INTO THIS WORK. AND MY PATH.

THE MURDERING OF MICHAEL BROWN AND, YOU KNOW, THE PROTESTING IN FERGUSON, AND EVOLUTION OF BLACK LIVES MATTER IN THAT TIME, AS WELL AS GOING INTO THE 2016 ELECTION AND ELECTION OF TRUMP WAS REALLY PRESENT BECAUSE THEY FELT LIKE MOMENTS AS WELL.

PART OF MY ROLE IN THAT WORK THEN, AND NOW, HAS BEEN TO SUPPORT FOLKS WHO IDENTIFY AS WHITE.

MOVING THROUGH THEIR EMOTIONS.

AND GROWTH.

IN ALIGNMENT, HOPEFULLY WITH BLACK LEADERSHIP IN THE POLITICAL UPRISINGS AND CATALYTIC POLITICAL MOMENTS. I THINK, SOME OF THE THINGS I AM STRUGGLING WITH IS, FOR FOLKS WHO HAVE BEEN, YOU KNOW INVOLVED IN ORGANIZING, INVOLVED IN RESOURCE.

DISTRIBUTION, LIKE, NWAMAKA AND I, AND FOLKS WHO HAVE BEEN GENERALLY ENGAGED IN POLITICAL --

AND CIVIC ENGAGEMENT, ELECTIONS.

WE HAD ALREADY SEEN THIS, YOU KNOW, RISING LEVEL OF EXTREME

RIGHT-WING, LIKE, LIKE EXTREME RIGHT-WING, BEING HIGHLY ORGANIZED.

HAVING A LOT OF POWER.

SHAPING THE PUBLIC DISCOURSE.

SHAPING POLICIES.

SHAPING THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH, THE JUDICIAL BRANCH.

AND --

SO THAT WAS SORT OF LOOK PRESENT.

IN A LOT OF WAYS.

I THINK WE HAVE STRUGGLED AROUND --

WHAT ARE THE FORMS OF POWER.

THAT WE WANT TO ENGAGE IN ON THE LEFT.

WE WILL TALK A LITTLE BIT MORE ABOUT THAT AS WE MOVE THROUGH.

BUT I THINK WHAT HAS BEEN EXTREMELY HARD IN THIS MOMENT --IS NOT ONLY ARE THOSE FORCES ORGANIZED ALL AROUND US, AND, ACTING COUNTER TO EQUITY, JUSTICE, AND THE MOVEMENTS THAT ARE UPRISING RIGHT NOW.

BUT THEY'RE ALSO, LIKE, STILL REPRESENTED BY OUR STATE. OUR STATE IS ACTING IN AN AUTHORITARIAN VIOLENT MILITARIZED CAPACITY.

IN SERVICE TO -- TO THE EXTREME AUTHORITARIAN FASCIST AND

OTHER VIOLENT MILITANT INTERESTS IN OUR COUNTRY.

THAT IS JUST -- THE REALITY OF WHERE WE SIT IN THIS MOMENT. AND I ALWAYS CAUTION LIKE, YOU KNOW, HOW WE ENGAGE IN THIS. BECAUSE I DON'T, I DON'T EVER WANT TO PROVOKE ANY KIND OF FEAR.

BUT I THINK IT IS JUST ONE OF THE THINGS NWAMAKA AND I TALK ABOUT IS HOW DO WE FIGURE OUT A LEVEL OF REDISTRIBUTION AND SUPPORT TO COMMUNITIES THAT IS COMMENSURATE TO THE HARM THAT HAS BEEN CAUSED.

AND THE LEVEL OF POWER WITH FOLKS WHO DO NOT VALUE THE --FOLKS WHO DO NOT VALUE THE DIGNITY AND HUMANITY OF BLACK LIFE, WHAT IS LEVEL OF RESPONSE COMMENSURATE TO THE FORCES THE I AM JUST VERY MUCH THINKING ABUT THAT RIGHT NOW. BECAUSE, WE HAVE SEEN THE WAY THAT THE STATE HAS THE NO, NO HESITATION IN ACTING IN VIOLENT WAYS.

I THINK THE OTHER THING I AM REFLECTING ON, EVEN AS WE EXPRESS DISSENT, THOSE WHO FEEL LOOK WE HAVE THE SAFETY TO DO SO, WE ARE BEING MET WITH VIOLENT FORCE.

SO WHAT DOES THAT SAY ABOUT OUR ABILITY TO STAND UP AND DEMAND SOMETHING ELSE IN THIS MOMENT?

AND I FIND THAT VERY, VERY TROUBLING.

FOR OUR DEMOCRACY, FOR THE STATE OF OUR COUNTRY, FOR THE

DIGNITY, HUMANITY, OF BLACK COMMUNITIES AND BLACK INDIVIDUALS HOW WE ARE GOING TO CONTINUE TO ORGANIZE AND RESPOND IN THIS MOMENT.

A COUPLE OF OTHER THINGS I WOULD SAY JUST QUICKLY.

I THINK I'M, THERE IS ALWAYS A CHALLENGE TO ENGAGE IN THIS CONVERSATION AND TO MEET FOLKS WHERE THEY ARE.

YOU KNOW, SOME OF YOU -- MAY JUST BE ENTERING INTO A CONVERSATION ABOUT RACE AND RACISM.

SOME OF YOU MAY HAVE BEEN IN THE CONVERSATION FOR YEARS. THERE IS ALWAYS THE SENSE LOOK WE HAVE TO KIND OF, YOU KNOW, BRING FOLKS ALONG.

I BELIEVE IN THAT.

I HAVE TO SAY THE LEVEL OF TRANSFORMATION WE ARE SEEKING IS, IS ENORMOUS.

WE ARE TALKING ABOUT -- SYSTEMS, AS NWAMAKA WAS SAYING, THE VERY INTENT OF THE SYSTEM IS TO PRODUCE WHAT IS HAPPENING RIGHT NOW.

I MEAN, OUR POLICE FORCE CAME TO BE AS, FREE PATROLS. OUR HEALTH CARE SYSTEM CAME TO BE AS ONE THAT PROTECTED WHITE AND SOME LEVEL OF CLASS PRIVILEGE FROM FOLKS WHO WERE UNHOUSED.

IN THE RECONSTRUCTION ERA AND WHO HAD THE CHANCE JUST LOOK

NOW OF INCREASING THE SPREAD OF PANDEMIC BECAUSE THEY DIDN'T HAVE ABILITY TO QUARANTINE OR BE IN STRUCTURES. THAT'S THE FOUNDATION OF OUR HEALTH CARE SYSTEM. THE FOUNDATION OF OUR GOVERNMENT AND OUR ECONOMY IS ONE ON STOLEN LAND, LABOR AND CULTURE.

SO, HOW DO WE, FOLKS WHERE A THERE, AND ALSO SAY, THE LEVEL OF TRANSFORMATION, THE REORGANIZATION, OF OUR ECONOMY, OUR DEMOCRACY, AND OUR VERY SORT OF CULTURE AND COSMOS, OUR WORLD VIEW ABOUT WHAT WE VALUE AND WHY, AND WHO THE SYSTEMS SERVE HAS TO COMPLETELY TRANSFORM.

AND SO, I AM JUST SITTING WITH THAT TENSION, OF WANTING TO -- HOLD PEOPLE WITH TENDERNESS.

HELP THEM TO FIGURE OUT HOW TO NAVIGATE THE MOMENT. AND WHAT IS NEEDED IN ORDER TO HONOR THE HUMANITY AND DIGNITY OF BLACK LIFE.

I'M HAPPY TO ASK YOU THE SECOND QUESTION.

IF YOU WANT TO REFLECT QUICKLY.

THEN WE CAN BREAK OUT.

SO AS YOU NOTICE, WE DO SOME OF THIS WORK BY MOVING RESOURCES, BUT OF COURSE IT IS SO MUCH MORE THAN THAT. BUT WE -- ALSO JUST WANTED TO SHARE WHAT WAS ON OUR HEART. AND THEN ALSO TRY TO CONNECT IT TO -- HOW YOU, HOW WE THINK, YOU ALL COULD BE THINKING ABOUT HOW THAT INFORMS YOUR GIVING AND OTHER WAYS OF ACTING IN THE MOMENT.

SO, I AM JUST CURIOUS, NWAMAKA, AS SOMEBODY THAT MOBILIZES RESOURCES AND GIVES RESOURCES WHAT THIS MOMENT IS SORT OF LOOK --

YEAH, WHAT YOU ARE THINKING ABOUT, WHAT THIS GIVING IS LIKE FOR YOU?

>> NWAMAKA AGBO: SURE.

I WILL TRY TO BE QUICK.

THE PIECE YOU OFFER ABOUT TRANSFORMATION IS IMPORTANT TO UNDERSCORE.

TRANSFORMATION ISN'T SOMETHING WHERE WE STUDY FIRST.

THEN GO OUT AND PRACTICE WHAT WE LEARN.

THERE IS THE OPPORTUNITY FOR US TO BE TRANSFORMED THROUGH THE DOING OF THE WORK.

I THINK, SOUTHERNERS ON NEW GROUND IN ATLANTA, ALLOW YOURSELF TO BE TRANSFORMED THROUGH THE WORK.

SO THERE IS A PLACE WHERE THERE IS A LEVEL OF URGENCY THAT REQUIRES US TO ACT.

AND REQUIRES US TO MOVE AS INTENTIONALLY AS WE CAN. KNOWING THAT WE MAY STUMBLE. BUT THAT, THAT IS REALLY THE LEARNING COMES IN.

WE ARE WILLING TO ACTUALLY TO LEARN.

FOR WHAT IT MEANS TO KIND OF STUMBLE.

AND ALL THAT IS TO SAY, I THINK THIS MOMENT IS ALSO -- WHAT I APPRECIATE ABOUT HOW --

DONORS AND PHILANTHROPIES AND FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS HAVE KIND OF 3450U6D TO RAPID RESPONSE AROUND COVID-19 -- KIND OF MOVED TO RAPID RESPONSE AROUND COVID-19 AND BLACK LIVES ORGANIZING, PEOPLE HAVE HELPED FLOW THE RESOURCES QUICKLY IN THIS MOMENT OF CRISIS.

I WOULD OFFER THAT WHAT WE ARE SEEING NOW IS OFTEN TIMES WHAT IS HAPPENING ON A DAY-TO-DAY BASIS IN COMMUNITY. INVITING PEOPLE TO THINK HOW THEY'RE GIVING IN THE MOMENT. NOT JUST A ONE-OFF.

BUT CAN ALSO, REALLY HELP SHAPE AND INFORM ONGOING GIVING OVER PERIOD OF TIME.

JEN AND I OFTEN TALK WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE IN RIGHT RELATIONSHIP WITH IMPACTED COMMUNITIES, SOCIAL UNIOUT ON THE GROUND AND HOW DO WE COME TO UNDERSTAND HOW TO KIND OF HONOR THE AUTONOMY OF THIS GROUP TO MAKE DECISIONS ON HOW TO USE THEIR RESOURCES AND SO I THINK ANNIE LEFT IT UP A REALLY BEAUTIFUL MODEL WITH THE MOVEMENT FOR BLACK LIVES AND HOW THIS ORGANIZATION HAS PULLED, ORGANIZED NUMBER OF BLACK LED GRASSROOTS ORGANIZATION AS CROSS THE COUNTRY TO BE A VEHICLE TO RECEIVE CAPITAL SO THEY CAN REDISTRIBUTE TO GROUPS ON THE GROUND.

ABILITY TO CULTIVATE RELATIONSHIPS, WITH GROUPS, AND SOCIAL MOVEMENTS AND RELATIVELY CALM TIMES IS THAT, WHAT, THAT IS WHAT THEN ALLOWS US TO ACT AND MOVE QUICKLY.

DURING THE MOMENTS OF CRISIS.

RIGHT.

SO WE CAN ACTUALLY REMAIN IN ON THE TRUST THAT WE HAVE WITH THE GROUPS TO MOVE THE RESOURCES.

SO, LAST ON THIS PIECE, I THINK --

FOR, ME AND MY WORK ON RESTORATIVE ECONOMIC AND RESTORATIVE ECONOMICS, FOR ME HAS BEEN ROOTED IN ENSURING THAT WE ARE BRINGING IN RACIAL ANALYSIS, AND ALSO OFFER GENDER JUSTICE ANALYSIS.

TO WHO WE ARE REINVESTING IN.

PARTICULARLY BLACK, INDIGENOUS COMMUNITIES, BROWN,

IMMIGRANT COMMUNITIES, EXTRACTED AND EXPLOITED FROM.

AND SO, I ALWAYS ASK PEOPLE TO THINK REALLY INTENTIONALLY ABOUT WHO WE ARE INVESTING IN.

WHO ARE THE PEOPLE?

HOW DO WE, HAVE -- AN ASSESSMENT AROUND THE RACIAL DIVIDE? WHAT WE ARE INVESTING IN?

WHAT ARE THE PROJECTS THAT ARE ACTUALLY SUPPORTING BLACK LIBERATION?

BLACK SELF DETERMINATION AND AUTONOMY.

THEN HOW ARE WE INVESTING IN, ARE WE ROOTED IN RIGHT RELATIONSHIP OR ARE WE BEING PRESCRIPTIVE AND ARE WE UNDUELY WE'LLING POWER AS DONOR OR ACTUALLY BEING COMMITTED STRUGGLE WITH FOLKS?

THOSE ARE GUIDING QUESTION THAT HELPED SUPPORT ME.

I THINK ABUT MY OWN GIVING.

AND ALSO THINK -- I THINK ABUT MY OWN GIVING.

AND ALSO THINK OF PEOPLE BEING IN DEEPER SOLIDARITY, SOCIAL MOVEMENTS, AND HAVE QUESTION HOUSE TO DO THAT. THEN ON THIS QUESTION, JEN, WANTED TO SEE IF YOU HAD ANYTHING TO ADD IN TERMS OF HOW YOU ARE THINKING ABOUT THIS CURRENT SOCIAL AND POLITICAL MOMENT AND HOW IT KIND OF, HELPS YOU, THINK ABOUT, HOW WE GIVE MONEY?

IN THIS MOMENT.

>> JENNIFER NEAR: YEAH, THANKS, NWAMAKA.

I THINK THE MOMENT AND SOME OF THE WORK THAT YOU AND I HAVE DONE, IN COVID-19, AND PRIOR TO THESE TWO INTERSECTING CRISIS, SUCH AN OPPORTUNITY FOR CROSS-CLASS WORK AND SHOWING CROSS-CLASS SOLIDARITY.

THOUGH I DON'T IDENTIFY AS A PERSON OF WEALTH, LIKE I SAID I COME FROM MORE WORKING, MIDDLE-CLASS BACKGROUND, EYE KNOW I LOOK FOR WAYS TO REDISTRIBUTE AS MUCH RESOURCIZE HAVE AS POSSIBLE.

TO REALLY DO IT THROUGH A SOLIDARITY AND MUTUALALITY FRAME NOT ONE OF CHARITY.

IT IS REALLY ABOUT, LIKE IF I HAVE RESOURCES, THAT I DO NOT NEED, AND THERE ARE FOLKS IN NEED OF RESOURCES THAT IS AN ACT OF MUTUALALITY AND SOLIDARITY.

NOT AN ACT OF CHARITY.

I FEEL LIKE THAT IS A FRAME THAT I AM REALLY TRYING TO LIVE INTO.

PERSONALLY AND THE WAY FOR OTHERS IN THE WORK. ANOTHER THING I WILL SAY IS, YOU KNOW, I AM FEELING THE TENSION AROUND REALLY LEANING INTO THE RELATIONSHIPS I HAVE.

AND CULTIVATING RELATIONSHIPS OVER MANY YEARS.

AND, HOW THOSE RELATIONSHIPS, INFORM WHAT THE NEEDS ARE, AND BEING ABLE TO MOVE MONEY AS, MONEY, AND WAYS THAT I, I KNOW -- WHAT THE NEEDS ARE. HOW TO SUPPORT.

BUT ALSO LOOK IN THIS MOMENT OF CRISIS.

IT IS ACCELERATING ACROSS SO MANY COMMUNITIES.

IN WHICH, WE, MAY NOT ALL HAVE RELATIONSHIPS.

ALL, JUST MOVING THE MONEY AND TRUSTING IT IS GOING WHERE IT NEEDS TO GO.

AND, CONTINUING TO TRY TO BUILD YOUR RELATIONSHIP AND, YOU KNOW, ONE OF THE THINGS I WOULD ALSO SAY, SOMEBODY WHO IDENTIFIES AS WHITE, I FEEL LIKE THERE IS NO ROOM FOR EGO, THERE IS NO ROOM FOR SENSE OF ENTITLEMENT.

WHAT I MEAN BY THAT IS LIKE, A LOT OF THE TIMES WHAT HAPPENS IN THIS WORK IS, FOLKS WHO CONTROL RESOURCES OR WANT TO GIVE RESOURCES FEEL AS THOUGH THEY HAVE SOME RIGHT TO SAY -- WHAT THE ACTIVITY AROUND ORGANIZING SHOULD LOOK LIKE.

HOW THE MONEY SHOULD, BE SPENT.

WHAT THE OUTCOME SHOULD BE.

AND I THINK IT'S JUST -- SUCH AN IMPORTANT PRACTICE, AS ANNIE WAS SAYING.

YOU WERE LIFTING UP.

TO EXERCISE A LETTING GOAT OF THE CONTRIAL.

AND NEEDING TO SOMEHOW THINK OF YOURSELF AS A BROKER IN THE

CHANGE PROCESS.

WHICH OFTEN IS VERY MUCH ROOTED IN EGO.

AND INSTEAD REALLY JUST LEANING INTO THE TRUST.

AND THE SELF DETERMINATION AND AGENCY OF COMMUNITY.

IN THIS MOMENT.

PREVIOUSLY AND IN THE FUTURE.

TO REALLY KNOW HOW THEY NEED TO RESPOND.

IN A WAY THAT HONORS THEIR OWN DIGNITY.

THOSE ARE THE THINGS THAT I HAVE BEEN REALLY, KIND OF REFLECTING ON IT.

THE LAST THING I WILL SAY IS -- YOU KNOW, AGAIN, THERE IS NOT TIME TO GIVE LIKE A FULL HISTORY HERE.

THERE IS SO MUCH ABOUT THE MOVEMENT OF MONEY, IN HISTORY THAT CAN INFORM THIS MOMENT.

AND STRUGGLES.

AND BEAUTIFUL THINGS.

AND, YOU KNOW, I THINK I HAVE BEEN TRYING TO MOVE MONEY, TO BLACK LIVE COMMUNITY ORGANIZING WORK, DEFINITELY.

WE WILL TALK MORE ABOUT SOME OF THE GIVING, SO WE ARE SEEING IN THIS MOMENT.

ALSO, JUST BASE BUILDING GROUPS.

WHO ARE IN THE LONG TERM STRUGGLE.

FOR EQUITY AND JUSTICE.

AND THEN ONE OF THE, THE AREAS, THAT I FELT -- I DON'T KNOW IF IT IS CHALLENGED BY WHAT, KIND OF GROWTH AREA FOR ME. IS LIKE, DIRECT CASH ASSISTANCE.

TO FOLKS WHATEVER THEY NEED.

WHATEVER THEY NEED.

LIKE, WHY IS THAT PART OF THE -- THE ECO SYSTEM OF GIVING. THAT'S JUST IN AN AREA, EXPLORATION FOR ME, FROM COVID-19, BEFORE THIS POLITICAL UPRISING AND THAT FEELS REALLY PRESENT NOW.

IF ORGANIZERS NEED A GENERATOR OR MEGA PHONE, WHATEVER, IT IS JUST LIKE, WE NEED MORE MONEY TO FLOW.

TO WHATEVER IT IS NEEDED RIGHT NOW.

IN THESE MOMENTS CRISIS.

>> NWAMAKA AGBO: WE ARE GOING TO INVITE, ADRIANA TO BREAK US OUT INTO BREAKOUT GROUPS.

WE WILL HAVE ROUGHLY, 35 PEOPLE.

HAVE ROUGHLY, FIVE PEOPLE IN A GROUP IF POSSIBLE.

ADRIANA, SEVEN GROUPS.

AND, WE WILL TAKE -- LET'S GO FOR 15 MINUTES.

PLAN TO RETURN BACK BY 5:05.

DO A HIGH-LEVEL REPORT OUT.

IN A MOMENT WE WILL DROP THE DISCUSSION QUESTIONS IN THE CHAT BOX.

BUT, YOU WILL HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO KIND OF FLOW THROUGH THE QUESTIONS.

OF, AS THEY RESONATE WITH YOU.

I LOVE FOLKS HAVE FACILITATION CONTRIBUTIONS EACH OF DON'T KNOW WHAT GROUP YOU WERE IN.

IF THAT WASN'T GROUP ONE, BREAKOUT ROOM ONE.

DOES SOMEBODY FROM BREAKOUT ROOM ONE WANT TO SHARE? GREAT.

BUT NOT TAKING OVER, I DON'T WANT TO NECESSARILY COHOST. I HAVEN'T YET.

RIGHT NOW WE HAVE REPORTERS THAT ARE, ALL RETURNING CITIZENS.

BUT WE DON'T HAVE A LOT OF MONEY TO PAY THEM.

AND SO -- YOU KNOW, I STRUGGLED WITH THAT.

I SHARED THAT.

AND THEN, I THINK, CAMILLE --

CAMILLE HELPED ME OUT.

IF YOU, IF YOU -- I KNOW SHE SHARED THAT, ABOUT GIVING, AND SORT OF --

HOW TO, INSTEAD OF GIVING, GIVING MORE MINDFULLY AND

SO, (LAUGHTER)

YEAH.

BUT, THANK YOU.

OTHERS THAT WANT TO GIVE A QUICK --

SHARE OUT FROM THEIR CONVERSATION?

>> I CAN SHARE FROM GROUP THREE.

THREE PEOPLE HAD TIME TO SPEAK.

AND I HAD STARTED TO -- GENERALLY-THERE WAS A FEELING BEING OVERWHELMED.

ONE OF OUR MEMBERS REALLY IS QUITE ANXIOUS.

THERE IS SO MUCH HAPPENING ALL AT ONCE.

WITH COVID-19.

AND, WITH THIS.

AS WE ENDED -- I STARTED TO RELATE THAT --

MY MOTHER WHO IS 75 YEARS OLD, AND, WAS LIVING IN THE UNITED STATES, HER ENTIRE LIFE -- TEXTED ME JUST SAYING, NETHERLANDS, SWEDEN AND IRELAND, PROTESTING BY THOUSAND FOR US.

IRELAND PROTESTERS AND HAVE U.S. EMBASSY DEMANDING JUSTICE FOR US!

I THE LATER TALKED TO MY UNCLE.

IMPORTANT TO HAVE THIS PERSPECTIVE.

BECAUSE THIS TOTALLY CHANGED HOW I FELT ABOUT EVERYTHING GOING ON.

MY UNCLE DOUG WHO IS 76, WHO -- WAS, PICKING COTTON AS A TEENAGER ENDED UP GETTING A PH.D. AT MIT, HE SAID, I ASKED HIM HOW DO YOU FEEL OH, PRETTY GOOD.

I WAS LIKE, WHY?

HE SAID IT IS DIFFERENT THIS TIME.

HE SAID, I SAID HOW?

HE SAID, WELL, IN THE '70S AND '60S WHEN THIS HAPPENED IT WAS JUST BLACK PEOPLE.

YOU DIDN'T SEE ANYBODY INTERNATIONALLY.

YOU DIDN'T SEE WHITE PEOPLE GETTING ARESTED AND BRUTALIZED

IN THE STREET BY THE COPS.

AND, ON BEHALF OF THIS CAUSE.

THE WAY YOU ARE SEEING IT NOW.

YOU DIDN'T SEE THESE KINDS OF --

HAPPENINGS.

SO, IT'S -- IT'S -- ALL OF A SUDDEN WE ARE SEEING, IN A WAY THAT IS JUST DIDN'T HAPPEN.

EVEN THOUGH EVERYTHING THAT PEOPLE ARE NOW WITNESSING ON CELL PHONE CAMERAS HAS BEEN HAPPENING FOR, YOU KNOW, 400, 500 YEARS.

SO -- YOU KNOW, IT LEFT ME MUCH MORE HOPEFUL.

BECAUSE THERE ARE MANY, MANY MORE PEOPLE.

AND, SADLY, I WOULD FINALLY ADD IS THAT -- THIS MAY BE NEW TO A LOT OF PEOPLE --

BUT IT IS ALSO NOT NEW TO A LOT OF PEOPLE.

SO I WILL LEAVE IT AT THAT.

THANK YOU.

THANK YOU FOR SHARING THAT.

MAYBE, -- IN THE TIME WE HAVE, TO INVITE IF THERE ARE ANY OTHER FINAL REFLECTIONS ANY BODY FEELS CALLED TO SHARE. THEN WE ARE JUST GOING TO JUST REFLECT A LITTLE BIT MORE ON KIND OF WAYS TO MOVE THROUGH GIVING IN THIS MOMENT. AND THEN, WE'LL HAVE A FEW MINUTES FOR ANY SORT OF BURNING QUESTIONS.

AND WE CAN FOLLOW-UP WITH RESOURCES AS WELL.

YEAH, IS THERE ANYONE ELSE THAT FEELS CALLED TO SHARE SOMETHING THAT CAME UP IN THEIR GROUP?

>> WELL OUR REPORT FROM GROUP FIVE.

AND IT KIND OF LEADS INTO WHAT, YOU'RE GOING TO NEXT.

-- AND IT KIND OF LEADS INTO WHAT YOU ARE GOING TO NEXT. IN ADDITION TO SHARING.

WE HAD ONE OF THREE PEOPLE IN OUR GROUP.

AND AD COMES FROM A CONSERVATIVE RURAL CALIFORNIA COMMUNITY.

AND, HE WAS -- SURPRISED THAT THE, AND, A SMALL COMMUNITY. BUT, FOUR MARCHES THAT WERE -- A MIXTURE OF PEOPLE IN COMMUNITY, THAT HE DIDN'T EXPECT TO SEE.

THAT THEY WERE PEACEFUL.

AND THEY BROUGHT OUT -- PEOPLE -- YOU KNOW, DIFFERENT RACES.

AND THEN, WE -- WE MOVED FROM THERE INTO TALKING ABOUT --JUST, MORE INTENTIONAL GIVING TO -- TO ORGANIZATIONS THAT REALLY TRULY PROMOTE SOCIAL JUSTICE CAUSES.

SO, ALL THREE OF US ARE -- ARE HEIGHTENING OUR AWARENESS

AND WANTING TO DO MORE, IN THAT AREA.

SO, THAT KIND OF LEADS INTO WHAT YOU ARE PLANNING TO TALK ABOUT NEXT.

WE ARE GOING TO BE SHARING DIFFERENT LINKS, RESOURCES INTO CHAT BOX.

WE WILL ALSO FOLLOW UP WITH ANNIE AND ADRIANA TO EMAIL THOSE AS WELL IN CASE YOU ARE NOT ABLE TO FULLY ACCESS THEM THROUGH THE CHAT BOX, I SEE A QUESTION.

BUT I WILL, SHARE MY, PIECES REALLY QUICKLY.

IN TERMS OF WHAT WE WOULD INVITE YOU TO THINK ABUT AS YOU MOVE THROUGH YOUR GIVING.

AFFECT YOUR CAPACITY FOR HUH TO ENGAGE IN DIRECT PROTEST. PEOPLE OFTENTIMES GET TRAINED TO SHOW UP IN THE SPACES. AND BEING ABLE TO ASSESS THE TIME YOU CAN GIVE. I ALSO INVITE PEOPLE TO THINK ABOUT, THERE IS A LIST OF(AUDIO DROP) DOING THE RESEARCH IS THERE A BAIL FUND IN YOUR COMMUNITY NEARBY COMMUNITY YOU CAN RESOURCE OR SUPPORT.

IS THERE A BLACK-LED ORGANIZATION, GRASSROOTS ORGANIZATION THAT IS PROVIDING DIRECT SUPPORT.

(AUDIO DROP) TO BE ABLE TO SUPPORT AND RESOURCE THEM AS WELL.

IN THE EVENT THAT YOU DON'T HAVE THE TIME, THE RESOURCES TO KIND OF DO ALL OF THIS RESEARCH THERE ARE ALSO A SET OF ORGANIZATIONS, NATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS, (AUDIO DROP) CAPACITY BUILDING ACROSS BLACK-LED ORGANIZING INFRASTRUCTURE.

AND, ARE ALSO HELPING TO REDISTRIBUTE FUNDS, TO MAKE SURE THAT THEY GET TO GROUPS ON THE GROUND.

(AUDIO DROP) MOVEMENT FOR BLACK LIVES.

(AUDIO DROP)

(INDISCERNIBLE).

>> ARE OTHER PEOPLE ABLE TO HEAR NWAMAKA?

>> I'M NOT.

NWAMAKA, WE CAN'T HEAR YOU.

>> ADRIANA ARIZPE MARTIN: WE LOST -- SHE HAS HER MUTE ON.

>> ADRIANA ARIZPE MARTIN: YEAH, NOW.

SHE IS TRYING TO SOLVE THE PROBLEM.

WHATEVER IT IS.

>> JENNIFER NEAR: YES, LET'S GIVE HER A MOMENT.

WHILE SHE RECONNECT I WILL JUST SAY THAT, NWAMAKA WAS TALKING SIMILAR THINGS I DROPPED INTO THE CHAT.

AND I THINK THERE IS -- I DON'T KNOW IF I AM SAYING THAT CORRECTLY.

THEY ASKED ANOTHER REALLY IMPORTANT QUESTION, WHICH WE CAN TALK A LITTLE BIT ABOUT.

IT REALLY DEPEND ON-YOU KNOW, YOUR RESOURCES.

BUT SOME FOLKS MIGHT HAVE INVESTED RESOURCES THAT ARE ALSO VERY MUCH WORKING COUNTER TO EQUITY AND JUSTICE.

AND TO THE MOVEMENT TO BLACK LIVES.

AND THE DEMANDS OF THIS MOMENT.

OFTENTIMES THEY CAN BE INVESTED IN PRIVATE PRISONS AND,

AND, OTHER PART THE MILITARIZED ECONOMY.

IF WE HAVE A MINUTE.

WE DIDN'T PREPARE CONTENT AS MUCH AROUND THAT.

BUT I APPRECIATE THAT QUESTION.

AND, NWAMAKA, IF YOU ARE BACK, I WAS GOING TO KICK IT BACK TO YOU TO PICK UP ON WHAT YOU WERE LEADING US THROUGH. CAN YOU HEAR US?

DO YOU WANT TO SEE IF YOUR AUDIO IS WORKING?

>> ADRIANA ARIZPE MARTIN: YOU ARE MUTED?

>> CAN ANYBODY TURN OFF HER MUTE?

THE HOST?

THERE.

>> NWAMAKA AGBO: OKAY.

SO SORRY, I HAD THE SPINNING WHEEL OF DEATH.

I WAS IN LIMBO LAND.

SO SORRY, THAT STRESSED ME OUT.

YEAH, I THINK, I THINK, JEN COVERED IT ESSENTIALLY. IF YOU DON'T HAVE RELATIONSHIPS WITH GROUPS DIRECTLY ON THE GROUND, TO SUPPORT ECO SYSTEMS WHERE BLACK LED ORGANIZATIONS HAVE -- HAVE, COLLECTIVELY ORGANIZED THEMSELVES TO HELP REDISTRIBUTE FUND THROUGHOUT THE ECO SYSTEM.

AND I WOULD OFFER THAT ONCE AGAIN, WE THINK THERE IS A MOMENT TO PROVIDE A DIRECT CASH SUPPORT TO ORGANIZATIONS ON THE GROUND, AND, OUR HOPE IS THAT PEOPLE ALSO CONTINUE TO CENTER BLACK LED ORGANIZING AND IMMIGRANT LED ORGANIZING AS PART OF THEIR GIVING PLAN, PART OF THEIR GIVING FOR THE FOLIO. WE KNOW THAT ONCE THE UPRISINGS ARE DONE.

THERE IS SO MUCH MORE WORK TO, AND THESE ARE THE GROUPS ON THE GROUND THAT ARE KIND OF LEADING THE FRONT LINE EFFORTS. SO, THAT OUR GIVING SHOULD KEEP THAT --

THAT FRONT AND CENTER.

THANKS, JENNIFER.

DROPPING IN ALL OF THE LINKS.

TO ORGANIZATIONS AND RESOURCES FOR SHARING.

DO WE WANT TO MOVE TO Q & A?

YOU ARE ON MUTE, SORRY, JEN.

>> JENNIFER NEAR: I WAS GOING TO ADD ONE OTHER QUICK POINT. WHICH IS -- I SUPPORT A GROUP THAT LOOKED AT THE WAY GRASSROOTS ENVIRONMENTAL GROUPS WORKED IN ALIGNMENT WITH BIG NATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS.

WHO ARE DOING WORK AROUND LIKE, ADVOCACY AND POLICY CHANGES.

AND TALK ABOUT, FOLKS DOING NARRATIVE WORK.

LIKE THEY ARE TRYING TO SHIFT THE CONVERSATION.

AND, THERE CAN BE A ROLE FOR THAT SORT OF WORK.

AND THERE TEND TO BE AT LEAST LIKE WITH LARGER FUNDERS ALSO GENERALLY IN GIVING AND DONORS.

THERE TENDS TO BE MORE OF LOOK AN APPETITE, AND COMFORT,

WITH FUNDING THAT KIND OF WORK.

IT IS OFTEN WHAT A LOT OF US IDENTIFY AS WHITE HAVE BEEN CONDITIONED TO THINK ARE THE LEVERS FOR CHANGE.

AND WE SEE OURSELVES, IN THOSE STRATEGIES.

BUT WHAT THEY OFTEN DON'T DO IS REALLY CENTER THE COMMUNITY AND THE LEVELS OF CHANGES AND THE WAYS OF APPROACHING CHANGE THAT FOLKS ON THE GROUND AND THE GRASSROOTS LEADERSHIP ARE TRYING TO CENTER.

SOMETIMES THEY'RE DIRECTLY COUNTER TO.

SO WE ALSO JUST WANT TO LIFT UP AS YOU ARE THINKING ABUT RESOURCES IN THE MOMENT.

REALLY LEAN INTO, MOVING RESOURCES, DIRECTLY TO THE BAIL AND BOND FUNDS.

MOVING MONEY TO BLACK-LED ORGANIZING AND LOCAL ECO SYSTEM, THOUGH THERE CAN BE A REQUEST FROM THE LARGER, CALL THEM, MORE LIKE THE GRASSTOP GROUPS.

SOMETIMES THERE IS TENSION ABOUT WHAT TO FUND, WHERE. AND SO, JUST WANTED TO LIFT THAT UP AS WELL.

>> THANK YOU, JEN.

>> NWAMAKA AGBO: I WOULD LOVE TO MOVE TO Q & A. AND, TO CATCH YOUR QUESTION IN THE CHAT BOX THERE. YES, I THINK JEN AND I CAN DEFINITELY FOLLOW UP WITH **RESOURCES**.

MISSION ALIGNED INVESTING.

IS OFTENTIMES A BODY OF WORK THAT WE BOTH NEED AND SUPPORT ON.

I THINK WE HAVE A PARTICULAR ANALYSIS ABOUT WHAT IT MEANS TO INVEST IN GRASSROOTS LED PROJECTS AS OPPOSED TO KIND OF HAVING OUR INVESTMENTS SIT PURELY ON, THE PUBLIC EQUITIES MARKET.

SO, IT MAY BE HELPFUL TO LOOK FIGURE HOW THE WE HAVE A FOLLOW-UP CONVERSATION HOW PEOPLE UNDERSTAND OUR ASSESSMENT AROUND WHAT IT MEANS TO INVEST AND WHERE OUR MONEY SITSABLE.

DO AGREE THERE IS AN OPPORTUNITY FOR PEOPLE TO -- LOOK AT -- SCREENS, AND, ENVIRONMENTAL SOCIAL, GOVERNMENT SCREENS, INVESTING IN PUBLIC EQUITIES MARKET.

I WOULD SAY ONE FOR A FIRM OUT OF SAN FRANCISCO IS ONE OF THE LEADING FIRMS THAT I HAVE SEEN IN TERMS OF HOW THEY INVEST ON THE PUBLIC EQUITIES MARKET IF THAT IS A PLACE WHERE YOU KIND OF KEEP YOUR INVESTMENT CAPITAL.

ANY OTHER QUESTIONS FOR US?

YOU CAN GO OFF MUTE OR TYPE IT INTO THE CHAT BOX. >> ANNIE MAHON: DID YOU SEE THE QUESTION IN THE CHAT BOX THERE?

>> NWAMAKA AGBO: CDFI, AND BERKSHIRE BANK IN MASSACHUSETTS IS, IS ALSO -- LEADING AND SUPPORTING BLACK PROJECTS. I -- YEAH, I THINK THE BLACK OWNED BANKS I HAVE SEEN, OR BLACK OWNED BANKS TEND TO BE LOCAL AND SPECIFIC TO PARTICULAR COMMUNITY.

REGARDLESS OF THE BLACK-LED BANG, I THINK IT IS IMPORTANT TO LOOK AT, WHO ARE THEY LENDING TO AND WHAT ARE THEIR POLICIES AROUND ALSO, INVESTING AND SUPPORTING A BLACK COMMUNITY TO ENSURE THAT IT IS NOT JUST BLACK AND GOVERNANCE, BUTS WE ALSO HAVE BLACK, WE HAVE IMPACT SUPPORTING BLACK COMMUNITIES.

BUT JEN ANY OTHER BLACK-OWNED BANKS THAT KIND OF COME TO MIND?

>> JENNIFER NEAR: YEAH, ALSO A GOOD OPPORTUNITY.

THERE IS SO MUCH TO SHARE AND UNPACK.

NWAMAKA AND I ALSO WORK ALONGSIDE COOPERATIVE LOAN FUNDS. SO, THERE IS BLACK LOANS LINKS, AND, FINANCE INSTITUTIONS WHICH ARE NOT ALWAYS THE SAME THING.

SOME TIMES CAN BE ACTING IN SERVICE TO COMMUNITY AND SOMETIMES NOT AS MUCH.

IT IS RAIL IN, UNDERSTANDING THE WORK AND THE -- IT IS

REALLY IN UNDERSTANDING THE WORK, RELATIONSHIP AND COMMUNITIES IN WHICH THEY OPERATE.

HARD FOR US TO GIVE GENERAL, A GOOD, YEAH, GOOD EXAMPLES. BUT THERE ARE A HANDFUL OF THOSE ACROSS THE COUNTRY THAT ARE NOT ONLY PREDOMINANTLY BLACK, INDIGENOUS, IMMIGRANT AND LIKE PEOPLE OF COLOR WORKING CLASS, LIKE IN THE GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE AND SERVING THE COMMUNITIES.

BUT THEY ALSO REALLY LEAN INTO THIS THING THAT I AM NOT GOING TO EVEN BE OPENING, WHICH IS THIS CONCEPT OF SHARED PROSPERITY.

SO WITHIN THIS ANTIRACISM, ANTI-CAPITALIST FRAME THAT WE WORK WITH.

IT IS REALLY IMPORTANT THAT WE ARE NOT JUST THINKING ABUT THIS COULD BE A WEBINAR TOPIC, JUST KIND OF SHARE IT. KNOW IT PROBABLY NEED TO BE UNPACKED MORE. WE ARE NOT JUST TALKING INDIVIDUAL PATHWAYS TO WEALTH. NOT TALKING INDIVIDUAL ENTREPRENEUR OR OWNERS OF CAPITAL, REIMAGINE ECONOMY, EQUITY, JUSTICE, SHARED PROSPERITY AND MORE COLLECTIVE GOVERNING AND STEWARDSHIP OF RESOURCES INCLUDING CAPITAL LAND, AND OTHER FORMS OF POWER AND INFRASTRUCTURE.

SO, THE EXAMPLE THAT, THAT YOU ALL COULD LOOK AT JUST TO

KIND OF SEE WHAT THAT MIGHT LOOK LIKE, THERE IS A PROJECT CALLED EUGEMA IN BOSTON, EUGEMA COOPERATIVE LOAN FUND, DROP IT IN THE CHAT, SEND IT OUT.

COOPERATION RICHMOND IN CALIFORNIA.

JUST, TWO, AGAIN, EXAMPLES, THESE AREN'T THE END-ALL, BE-ALL, JUST MODELS.

THEY'RE JUST A COUPLE THINGS TO, YEAH, REFLECT ON.

THANKS, NWAMAKA, I SEE YOU.

ANYTHING YOU WOULD ADD TO THAT POINT AS WELL?

>> NWAMAKA AGBO: NO, I THINK YOU GOT IT.

>> JENNIFER NEAR: I WILL JUST SAY ON THE SCREENING THING. HOW IMPORTANT IT IS PARTICULARLY IN THIS MOMENT.

TO -- TO -- ENSURE LIKE, IF YOU HAVE ANY KIND OF PRIVATE OR INSTITUTIONAL ASSETS THAT YOU ARE NOT INVESTED IN PRIVATE PRISONS, THERE IS JUST SO MUCH MONEY THAT ACTUALLY DRIVES OUR INCARCERATION AND MILITARIZED STATE.

AS NWAMAKA SAID, WORK WITH SOMEWED TO SCREEN THOSE.

AND THEN, YOU KNOW THE OTHER THING, WE COULD SHARE, A MUCH LONGER CONVERSATION, JUST TO KIND OF FEED THIS IDEA, IS IN ADDITION TO GRANTS, SOMEBODY WAS SAYING, SOMETIMES COMMUNITIES AND COMMUNITY PROJECTS ARE ALSO LOOKING FOR LOW INTEREST OR ZERO INTEREST LOANS. OR OTHER FORMS OF CAPITAL AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE. IN THEIR PROJECTS.

SO, WE ALWAYS ENCOURAGE REALLY BEING OPEN TO MOVING A VARIETY OF DIFFERENT KINDS OF CAPITAL.

TO THE WORK.

AS PART OF THAT ALSO THINKING OF THE INVESTMENT SIDE AS WELL LIKE GIVING SIDE.

>> NWAMAKA AGBO: UH-HUH.

CORDATA CAPITAL IS ONE OF THE LINKIZE DROPPED IN THERE. INDIVIDUALS LIKE, KATE POOL, MYSELF AND OTHERS, JEN, WE COULD ALSO, PEOPLE HOW TO STRUCTURE TREBGT INVESTMENTS IN THE EVENT THAT PEOPLE DO WANT TO MOVE INTO SOME TYPE NONEXTRACTED INVESTMENT TO A GROUP.

BUT, BUT, DON'T KNOW HOW TO STRUCTURE THAT DEAL. SO WE CAN FIND INDIVIDUAL TO SUPPORT THAT AS WELL. >> ANNIE MAHON: WHAT'S THE BEST WAY FOR PEOPLE, IS IT OKAY FOR PEOPLE TO REACH OUT DIRECTLY TO YOU?

>> JENNIFER NEAR: WITH THAT, I WILL JUST SAY, YEAH, THANK YOU TO Y'ALL.

I REALLY FELT SOME OF THE THINGS THAT FOLKS REFLECTED BACK AROUND.

A LITTLE SENSE OF OVERWHELM.

ALSO, LIKE, WE SCRATCHED THE SURFACE OF A LOT OF DIFFERENT THEUPGZ THAT ARE DEEP.

LOOK I SAID I THINK THERE IS SO MUCH NEED FOR REFLECTION, LEARNING, INQUIRY AND IN THIS MOMENT.

IN THESE, YEAH, CHAOTIC TIMES.

SO, THANK YOU.

THANK YOU, TO ANNIE AND ADRIANA AS WELL.

>> ADRIANA ARIZPE MARTIN: ANNIE.

>> ANNIE MAHON: THANK YOU SO MUCH, NWAMAKA, AND JEN.

AS I SHARED WITH THEM DURING THE BREAKOUT GROUP.

I SENT THREE FIRE SYMBOLS TO MY DAUGHTER, HANNAH TO DESCRIBE HOW IT WAS GOING.

I JUST THINK IT WAS AMAZING.

AND, SO POWERFUL.

AND I WANT TO SHARE WITH EVERYONE HERE, WHO IS IN THE MINDFULNESS TRADITION THAT WE HAVE, WE HAVE STARTED A GROUP, VERY SMALL GROUP.
