SO THIS IS A GOOD CAP ON THE END LAST TIME. SO THIS WHOLE LEGACY OF UNEVEN DEVELOPMENT, THE WAY WE, YOU KNOW WE HAVE SEGREGATED RACIALLY LIKE, BY INCOME, WEALTH, BUILDING OUR COMMUNITIES RIGHT. YOU KNOW, IT IS A GREAT CAPTION RIGHT? I JUST GOT A \$200,000 TAX CULT. I LOVE THIS COUNTRY. BUT WHY IS IT SUCH A DUMP? IT IS LIKE THE PERFECT TEACHING OF, I'M LIKE THIS BECAUSE YOU ARE LIKE THAT. YOU ARE LIKE THAT BECAUSE I AM LIKE THIS. AND YET, BECAUSE OF THE CLOUDINESS OF OUR MIND AND HEART, OUR GREED AND OUR AVERSION AND OUR DELUSIONS DON'T ALLOW US TO SEE HOW WHAT IS HAPPENING TO ME IS IMPACTING OTHERS AND VICE VERSA, RIGHT? SO THIS IS KIND

OF WHERE WE ENDED TALKING ABOUT THE HISTORY OF THIS
INVESTMENT IN BLACK COMMUNITIES, IN LOW-INCOME COMMUNITIES,
IN THE, AS A FOUNDATIONAL WAY THAT THE UNITED STATES OF
AMERICA WAS BUILT. AND THIS IMAGE HERE FROM WILKENSON
PICKETT, WHY GREATER QUALITY MAKES SOCIETY STRONG, THE BOOK
AND THE RESEARCH THAT INFORM THAT BOOK JUST SHOWS ACROSS
THE WORLD HOW THE GREATEST INEQUITY, COUNTRIES WITH THE
GREATEST INEQUITY HAVE THE POOREST HEALTH. AND THE
COUNTRIES THAT ARE MOVING MORE TOWARDS EQUITY HAVE BETTER
HEALTH. AND SO, THIS CAPTION HERE AND THIS IMAGE SORT OF
WRAPS IT UP. IT'S REALLY A GOOD --

RIGHT HERE. I WANT TO ALSO INVITE IN AS WE DID LAST TIME
THAT WHEN YOU SEE THE IMAGE OF A NATURE SLIDE IT IS AN
INVITATION TO TAKE A BREATH IN AND JUST RESENTER, JUST,
FOLLOW YOUR BREATH AND JUST COME BACK HOME. (RECENTER) WHAT
WE ALSO KNOW WHEN WE START TALKING INEQUITIES, THERE IS A
WAY THAT PEOPLE WHO -- HAVE ANY KIND OF POWER AND, WHEN I
SAY POWER, I MEAN, THINKING ABOUT SOCIAL LOCATIONS AND HOW,
YOU KNOW WHEN YOU DO WORK AROUND, ANTIRACISM,

ANTI-OPPRESSION, OR WHAT SOME NOW, NOW ADAYS CALL THE, THE DEI WORK, WE KIND OF PAINT A PICTURE, POWER ANALYSIS OF

THE, THE WAY POWER IS DISTINGUISHED OR DISTRIBUTED IN THE WORLD REALLY. CERTAINLY IN THIS COUNTRY. ACCORDING TO RACE, IT IS PEOPLE, YOU KNOW, JUST -- JUST IN A VERY DUALISTIC WAY. AND WE KNOW THERE IS, YOU KNOW THERE IS, THERE IS --DIFFERENT WAYS THIS PLAYS OUT, RIGHT? CRITICAL RACE THEORY. TELLS US A LITTLE BUILT MORE ABOUT HOW THERE IS INTERSECTING, RIGHT. THESE LOOK OUT, LOCATIONS INTERSECT, BUT JUST IN THE MOST SIMPLISTIC WAY. THERE IS RACIALLY, THERE IS -- SAY TO PEOPLE -- WHO ARE WHITE HAVE POWER AND PEOPLE WHO AREN'T DON'T HAVE POWER. GENDERWISE. WE WOULD SAY MALE BODIED PEOPLE HAVE POWER OVER FEMALE BODIED PEOPLE. INCOMEWISE, WE WOULD SAY PEOPLE, WITH MONEY, RESOURCES, DIFFERENT KINDS OF RESOURCES, NOT JUST MONEY HAVE POWER, OVER PEOPLE WHO DON'T. WHO DON'T HAVE THOSE ASSETS, THOSE RESOURCES. SEXUAL ORIENTATION. WE WOULD SAY PEOPLE WHO ARE HETEROSEXUAL, CLAIM HETEROSEXUALITY HAVE POWER OVER THOSE WHO DON'T. BIRTH -- IN THIS COUNTRY --FOLKS BORN HERE HAVE POWER OVER THOSE WHO DON'T. AND IT GOES LIKE THAT. YOU CAN REALLY --WE ARE NOT GOING TO DO IT ALL. I AM JUST SAYING THAT WHENEVER WE TALK ABOUT ANY ONE POWER DUALISM AND IN THIS

CASE WE ARE TALKING A LOT ABOUT RACE AND CLASS. THERE IS

THIS COMFORT FOR PEOPLE -- THERE IS DISCOMFORT FOR PEOPLE
WHO ARE IN EITHER CATEGORIES, NOT JUST RACIALLY, AND CLASS,
BUT OTHER IDENTITIES. SO --

IF WE ARE GOING TO REALLY HAVE DEEP CONVERSATIONS TO

TRANSFORM AND HEAL, WE ARE GOING TO HAVE TO LEARN HOW TO

BE -- UNCOMFORTABLE, COMFORTABLE WITH THE DISCOMFORT.

RIGHT? SO THESE SLIDES OF NATURE IS A WAY TO IN THE MIDST

OF DISCUSSIONS LIKE THIS, THAT --

THAT WE CAN COME BACK TO A BREATH AND KEEP GROUNDING OURSELVES.

FOR US THAT HAVE THIS PRACTICE, WE KNOW WHAT THAT MEANS WHEN YOU ARE INVITED TO TAKE A BREATH IN. ONE KNOW ONE BREATH BEGINS TO BRING US BACK. TWO BREATHS, THEN THREE. RIGHT, SO THE SLIDES OF NATURE -- WE ALSO KNOW THAT JUST LOOKING AT A SLIDE OF NATURE, BEGINS TO -- RELAX THIS VEGAL DISASSOCIATION, THIS FIGHT/FLIGHT. THERE IS MANY THINGS THAT HAPPEN WHEN YOU SEE SLIDES OF NATURE AND TAKING A BREATH. SEE THE SLIDES OF NATURE, EVERY, THREE, FOUR SLIDES THAT WE DID LAST TIME. THIS IS TO HELP US JUST STAY PRESENT. BECAUSE EVERYBODY -- CAN GET TRIGGERED. I KNOW TRIGGER IS LIKE AN OVERUSED WORD THESE DAYS. YET OUR SYSTEM GETS ACTIVATED OR SHUTDOWN. WE

DISASSOCIATE. OR WE JUST WANT TO LEAVE, OR FLIGHT. JUST TAKE CARE OF YOURSELF. RIGHT? LIKE GET UP AND WALK AWAY. OR WHATEVER YOU NEED TO DO TO TAKE CARE OF YOURSELF. SO YOU WILL SEE THESE KINDS OF SLIDES. THIS IS THE TITLE THAT WE STARTED WITH LAST TIME. LAST MONTH. EMERGING FROM THE ILLUSION OF SEPARATION. MINDFUL RESISTANCE OF UNEVEN DEVELOPMENT IN BLACK AND BROWN COMMUNITIES IN BALTIMORE. IF YOU REMEMBER WE TALKED THE RED LINE MAP. THIS IS BALTIMORE'S. WE TALKED RED LINE MAPS FOR ANY CITY. AND THAT -- IF YOU THINK OF A PERSON'S BODY, SUPER IMPOSED HERE, AND THE EMERGING FROM THIS ILLUSION IS --THE UNDERSTANDING IS THAT IF WE OURSELVES ARE NOT FRAGMENTED, WE WOULDN'T CREATE CITIES THAT ARE FRAGMENTED. STATES, COUNTRIES, THAT ARE FRAGMENTED. AND SO, THIS --THIS IS REALLY --

I REALLY LIKE TO SUPER IMPOSE THIS FIGURE AS WE DID IN THE FIRST HALF. BECAUSE WE CAN'T GET AWAY FROM THE FACT THAT SYSTEMS ARE BUILT BY PEOPLE. IT WAS INDIVIDUAL WHOSE WHO, WHO DREW THESE MAPS. BASED ON THEIR, PERCEPTIONS. OF WHAT WAS RIGHT AND NOT RIGHT. AND SO --

IT IS REALLY GOOD, NOT JUST CHANGING THE SEGREGATION WE SEE
HERE ON THE RED LINE MAP OF BALTIMORE, IT IS ALSO CHANGING

THE WAY THE INDIVIDUALS ARE SEEING. SO THAT THEY CAN

HAVE -- THE INSIGHT AND HEART SPACE TO, TO HAVE DEEPER

UNDERSTANDING --

AND NOT DRAW MAPS LIKE THIS THAT CONTINUE TO BE DRAWN.

RIGHT? WE STILL --

THE BANKING INDUSTRY STILL LENDS MONEY ACCORDING TO RACE

AND CLASS. THIS EMERGING FROM THE HISTORY WE HOLD IN OUR,

BODIES, HEARTS, CITIES, HOUSEHOLDS, IS KIND OF LIKE, I

THINK SOMETIMES, THIS LITTLE TUGBOAT PUSHING THIS BIG OLD

BARGE IN FRONT OF IT. IT IS A HARD THING, RIGHT? IT IS LIKE

GOING -- AGAINST --

THE STREAM. IT IS GOOD TO ACKNOWLEDGE SOMETIME THAT, THE WORK OF --

FREEDOM -- FREEDOM, POLITICAL FREEDOM, SOCIAL FREEDOM, AND,
AND ALSO, ESPECIALLY --

THE FREEDOM INSIDE OURSELVES. IT IS HARD WORK. AND IT, IT

ACTUALLY HURTS. RIGHT. SOME ONE SAID TO ME THE OTHER DAY,

UM --

THIS, THIS MEDITATION STUFF, SOMEONE MORE RECENT IN THE PRACTICE, THAT IT IS PAINFUL THAT THE THINGS THAT ARE COMING UP, THEY'RE REALLY PAINFUL THEY DON'T KNOW IF THEY WANT TO DEAL WITH IT. RIGHT? SO ALL OF US KNOW WHO HAVE

BEEN PRACTICING KNOW THAT THIS IS THE TRUTH. AND SO -THAT KIND OF, LOOKING INSIDE OURSELVES TO, TO, TO -- KIND
OF --

DIG IN TO FIND THAT INNER SELF, THAT MORE -
TRUE SELF, THAT MORE, THE, THE DIAMOND IN THE ROUGH THING.

IT IS HARD, IT IS -- AND IT HURTS. AND I THINK THIS WORK,

THIS, ON THE SOCIAL LEVEL, IT IS, IT HURTS TOO AND IT'S

HARD WORK. AND IT'S --

AND WE WANT TO TURN AWAY FROM IT. BECAUSE WE DON'T WANT TO THINK ABOUT --

HOW DID I PARTICIPATE IN IT. HOW DIDN'T I PARTICIPATE? HOW DID THAT HAPPEN? WHAT WAS I DOING WHEN ALL THAT WAS HAPPENING? WHAT WERE MY PARENTS DOING? RIGHT, AND -- FOR AND FOR THOSE OF US WHO MAYBE STILL LIVE IN THESE COMMUNITIES THAT ARE -- THE LEGACY OF THIS, UNEVEN DEVELOPMENT, --

THE TRAUMA OF, BEING IN COMMUNITIES THAT ARE STILL SEGREGATED AND STILL --

INVESTED. AND TRYING TO HEAL THAT TRAUMA IS ALSO HARD WORK AND VERY PAINFUL. YEAH. SO THE BIG THING ABOUT EMERGING FROM FRAGMENTATION OF ANYKIND IS THE COMMUNITY. IS, BECAUSE WHAT, WHAT FRAGMENTATION DOES, WHAT SEPARATION DOES IS

IF YOU REMEMBER, LAST TIME, IT MOVES US FROM, A KPAOUPB TEE OF COHESION, RIGHT? PEOPLE LIVING TOGETHER TAKING CARE OF EACH OTHER. SO THERE IS LIKE -- IT IS LIKE WATER, COHESION.

YEAH? AND THEN --

OVER TIME, OF THIS CONTINUED SOAP RATION FRAGMENTATION, WHICH IS WHAT GENTRIFICATION AND DISPLACEMENT HAS DONE TO, BLACK COMMUNITIES, SERIOUSLY FORCED TO BE DISPLACED, IT GOES FROM KPAOUPB TEES LIVING TOGETHER, TAKING CARE OF EACH OTHER (COMMUNITIES) OVER AND OVER, UNTIL YOU HAVE PEOPLE LIVING TOGETHER. PEOPLE ARE TAKING CARE OF EACH OTHER. THERE IS NO SOCIAL CAPITAL. IN THE COMMUNITY. AND SO THAT DOESN'T ALLOW PEOPLE TO ORGANIZE AND BUILD POWER TO SPEAK UP FOR THEMSELVES, TO HAVE THE POWER TO -- TO CHALLENGE POLICY. SPECULATIVE DEVELOPMENT, ETC. AND SO, EMERGING FROM THIS FRAGMENTATION REALLY MEANS WHEN WE COME BACK TOGETHER AS A COMMUNITIES, ORGANIZED COMMUNITIES, WE, WE ADHERE AND WE HAVE COHESION AGAIN. AND THAT THIS POWER THAT WE LOST FROM BEING SO FRAGMENTED WE GET, WE REGAIN SOME OF THAT POWER. RIGHT, WE HAVE -- STRONG NETWORKS AND SET STRONG NETWORKS, WHOLENESS TOGETHER. WE GET CAPITAL, SOCIAL CAPITAL. WE PARTICIPATE AGAIN. BECAUSE WE FEEL VALUE. WE,

AND WE KNOW SOME ONE HAS GOT OUR BACK. AND WE KNOW, OUR VOICE IS HEARD. IT'S NOT JUST --

YOU KNOW, PUSHED TO THE SIDE. SO WE ACTUALLY GO TO CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS, RIGHT? AND IF THERE IS ORGANIZATIONS IN THE COMMUNITY, ORGANIZING FOLKS TO GO TO LIKE THIS EVENING THERE IS A BIG CITY HALL MEETING. ONYX ON NEW BILL THAT WAS INTRODUCED, LEGISLATION, THAT -- LEGISLATION THAT SAYS TAXING CANNIBAS, THAT THE MAJORITY OF, I THINK, NOT THE MAJORITY, 35% OF THAT, NEEDS TO GO BACK INTO THE COMMUNITIES THAT HAVE BEEN ATTACKED THROUGH THE WAR ON DRUGS. RIGHT? IF YOU THINK ABOUT IT WE ARE KIND OF MOVING IN THIS WAY. NOW CANNIBAS IS OKAY TO BE SOLD. AND ALL OF THESE PEOPLE INCARCERATED AND THE EFFECT OF THAT, THE EVISCERATION OF OUR COMMUNITIES BY HAVING SO MANY IN, IN OUR LOW-INCOME PLAQUE COMMUNITIES HAVING SO MANY, YOUNG BLACK MEN INCARCERATED. THAT'S PART OF, THAT IS ANOTHER FORM OF DISPLACEMENT. AND FRAGMENTATION OF COMMUNITIES. (LOW-INCOME BLACK COMMUNITIES) ORGANIZING PEOPLE TODAY TO GO TO CITY HALL TO SUPPORT AND TESTIFY ON THAT LEGISLATION, SO PEOPLE WILL GO TO THAT, WHEN THEY FEEL THEY'RE PART OF A COMMUNITY. RIGHT? THEY SEE PEOPLE LIKE THEM GOING AND TESTIFYING. AND THAT GIVES THEM THE SPIRIT OFF TO DO THE

SAME. SO COMING OUT OF THIS FRAGMENTATION AND, AND REBUILDING THIS --

THIS COHESION IS SO CRITICAL. AND IT STARTS WITH THE INDIVIDUAL, RIGHT? IT STARTS WITH -- EACH OF US. THIS CHANGE HAPPENS IN ANYTHING. SO THESE ARROWS NEED TO BE OPPOSITE. IF YOU LOOK, OH, THERE IS MY LITTLE CURSOR, OKAY, HERE. THIS ARROW NEEDS TO BE TURNING BACKWARDS. SO THIS CIRCLE WANTS TO STAY THAT -- SAY THAT CHANGE HAPPENS ON THE INDIVIDUAL LEVEL. AND THEN THE INDIVIDUAL, IN THEIR OWN SPHERE OF INFLUENCE, WHAT WE CALL, LIKE THEIR FAMILY, THEIR, THEIR COMMUNITY, THEIR NEIGHBORHOOD, THEIR WORK PLACE, THEIR SCHOOL PLACE. YOU KNOW, WHERE THEY GO TO DANCE. AND HANG OUT, OR WHERE THEY PLAY MUSIC. THEY AFFECT THAT AREA THAT THEY'RE IN. AND THAT ORGANIZATIONAL LEVEL IF YOU WILL. AND THEN -- AND THEN THAT GETS LARGER. IT AFFECTS THE WHOLE SOCIETY, SOCIETAL SYSTEMS. THE STRUCTURES. THE POLICY. RIGHT? YOU KNOW, THAT RED LINING MAP. THE POLICY CREATED BASED ON THAT RED LINE MAP OF WHO WOULD GET LOANS, RIGHT. THAT BECAME A STRUCTURE. IN THE WAY THAT MONEY WAS LOANED AND KPAOUPB TEES WERE BUILT. -- COMMUNITIES WERE BUILT. SO WHEN WE START CHANGING OURSELVES, WE START IMPACTING ALL OF THIS, RIGHT. SO THE REASON, THIS LITTLE

DIAGRAM, I THINK MANY OF YOU KNOW IT. DIDN'T HAVE THE

ARROWS GOING BOTH WAYS, MARISELA WAS TRYING TO PUT ARROWS

GOING BOTH WAYS, SEE WHAT SHE DID, PUT THEM GOING THE SAME

WAY. SO THEY NEED TO BE GOING IN OPPOSITE DIRECTION BECAUSE

WHAT I WAS TRYING TO SAY HERE --

IS THAT -- NOT ONLY DOES THE SOCIETY INFLUENCE THE INDIVIDUAL DIRECTLY, BUT THE INDIVIDUAL CAN DIRECTLY INFLUENCE SOCIETY AND IN A BIGGER AT THAT LEVEL. AND SO --ALL OF THIS GOES BACK AND FORTH. RIGHT STATE ISN'TJUST ONE, IT IS NOT A ONE WAY THAT WE AFFECT CHANGE. SO THE, THE UNDERSTANDING IS THAT SOME TIMES WE THINK, SOCIAL JUSTICE MOVEMENTS THAT IT IS ALL ON THE ORGANIZATIONAL AND ON THE SYSTEM, THAT AFFECTS THE SYSTEM. AND WE THINK ABOUT THE INDIVIDUAL AS FAR AS -- THE INDIVIDUAL COMING TOGETHER TO ORGANIZE GROUP OF PEOPLE, YOU KNOW, COLLECTIVE. WHAT WE STILL IN MANY SPACES HAVEN'T -- WE TALK ABOUT IT -- BUT WE STILL AREN'T DOING YET -- I THINK SUFFICIENTLY IS THE INSIDE OURSELVES WHAT HAPPENS WHEN WE BREATHE AND WE START COMING BACK TO OUR BODY AND HOW WE DEVELOP STILLNESS SO WE CAN SEE WHAT WE ARE DOING. SO WE CAN HEAR THE WORDS WE ARE SAYING. WHEN WE SPEAK TO SOMEONE. ARE WE BEING VIOLENT? ARE WE ATTACKING THE PERSON BECAUSE WE SEE THEM AS OUR ENEMY?

AND SO ARE WE DOING THE SAME KIND OF THINGS THAT HAVE BEEN DONE TO US IN THE NAME OF JUSTICE? RIGHT? WE ALL DO THIS. I HAVE DONE THIS A LOT IN THE PAST. RIGHT? IT'S PART OF HOW WE WERE TRAINED TO DO THE WORK. UNFORTUNATELY. AND THERE IS CHANGE NOW. WE TALK ABOUT. WE DON'T WANT TO BE TRANSACTIONAL, WE WANT TO BE TRANSFORMATIONAL, DO DEEP CHANGE. BRING A DIFFERENT WAY OF BEING IN OUR JUSTICE SPACES DOING THE WORK HOW WE REBUILD COMMUNITIES AND ALL OF THE DIFFERENT SEGMENTS OF THE COMMUNITIES RIGHT. TRANSPORTATION, HOUSING, EDUCATION, RECREATION, AND, EVERYTHING. RIGHT? EDUCATION, HEALTH. SO, IN ALL OF THE SPACES THAT WE ARE DOING THIS WORK, WE WANT TO THINK ABOUT HOW WE ARE INDIVIDUALLY TRANSFORMING OURSELVES. THAT'S WHERE OUR PRACTICE IS, PEOPLE PRACTICE MINDFULNESS, OR PRACTICE WITH A DIFFERENT WAY OF PAUSING AND BEING REFLECTIVE TO SEE WHAT IT IS THAT YOU ARE BRINGING INTO THE SPACE, RIGHT? AND THIS, THAT PART OF THE, THE TITLE, THE MINDFULNESS, YOU KNOW, A LOT OF US HERE ARE MINDFULNESS PRACTITIONERS. SO, WE UNDERSTAND WHAT THAT MEANS, RIGHT. WE KNOW THAT WHO WE ARE IS WHAT WE ARE BRINGING INTO THE SPACE. AND SO THAT INDIVIDUAL CHANGE IS SO, SO CRITICAL. I THINK A LOT OF US WHO DO THE WORK OF REBUILDING

COMMUNITIES, FOR JUSTICE, IN DIFFERENT SECTORS. A LOT OF US GOT THE ORGANIZATIONAL CHANGE DOWN. YOU KNOW, WE DO THE POWER ANALYSIS, WHO HAS GOT THE POWER, WHICH POLITICIANS DO WE NEED TO -- TO, TALK TO. YOU KNOW, STRATEGIZE. WE HAVE THE SYSTEMS, THIS IS HOW THE SYSTEM IS FLAWED. WE NEED TO CHANGE THE LEGISLATION. WE NEED TO INTRODUCE LEGISLATION. WE NEED TO DO A DIFFERENT PROGRAM. THEN WE NEED TO REPLICATE IT. SCALE IT. A LOT OF US, YET HAVEN'T BEEN ABLE TO STOP, LONG ENOUGH, AND FIND THAT STILLNESS. WHAT WE NEED TO HEAL. SO THE WAY WE STEP INTO THE SPACES OF CHANGE IS ALSO REFLECTIVE OF THE LOVE THAT WE SAY THAT WE WANT TO BRING INTO SPACES. SO WE DON'T HATE FOLK WHO ARE DOING THE WRONG THING. RIGHT? THOSE OF YOU FAMILIAR WITH BALTIMORE, IT IS GETTING TO BE, WARM TEMPERATURES. AND THEN THE DIRT BIKES ARE OUT. SO WE, WE HAVE A LOT OF FOLK IN THE, YEAH, WHERE I LIVE, ON BROADWAY HERE, MAN, IT IS LIKE, ONE OF THOSE MAIN STREETS THAT FOLK DO THE DIRT BIKE OUTING. ESPECIALLY, FRIDAY, SATURDAY EVENINGS. THAT WAS THE BACKGROUND IF YOU HEARD IT. YEAH, OKAY, I WILL INVITE YOU FOR A BREATH. I LEARNED LAST NIGHT. IF I STAY ON THE SLIDE TOO LONG, I HAVE TO GO OUT. AND COME BACK. I THINK I HAVE TO STOP THIS SHARE SCREEN. AND THEN GO BACK. WHAT I WOULD

LOOK TO NOW TALK ABOUT IS SORT OF THE BIG FRAMEWORK OF -THE KIND OF CHANGE THAT VOLAR, VILLAGE OF LOVE AND
RESISTANCE, WHICH I WILL FOCUS IN ON AS AN EXAMPLE. AND YOU
KNOW, VOLAR ITS NOT THE ONLY GIG IN TOWN. ACTUALLY IN
BALTIMORE THERE ARE OTHER ORGANIZATIONS THAT ARE ALSO DOING
AWESOME WORK AROUND LAND JUSTICE, COMMUNITY LAND TRUST
MOVEMENTS, SO, I WANT TO SHOUT THAT OUT. AND I WILL FOCUS
ON VOLAR, THAT IS THE ORGANIZATION I AM PART OF. AND I
THINK WE ARE DOING GOOD STUFF. THE FREIGHT WORK, THE BIGGER
FRAMEWORK THAT WE ARE WORKING ON IS, A SOLIDARITY ECONOMY
FRAMEWORK. RIGHT? AND SO THIS IS, FOR THOSE OF YOU WHO MAY
NOT BE FAMILIAR, IT REALLY IS -- A MOVEMENT THAT IS LOOKING
AT --

BRINGING ALL OF THE PIECES TOGETHER IN HOW WE THINK ABOUT
EQUITY AND JUSTICE. RIGHT? SO, HERE I WILL READ THIS,
SOLIDARITY ECONOMY IS A GLOBAL MOVEMENT TO BUILD -- I HAVE
TO MOVE THE LITTLE THING HERE. TO BUILD A JUST AND
SUSTAINABLE ECONOMY WHERE WE PRIORITIZE PEOPLE AND THE
PLANET OVER ENDLESS PROFIT AND GROWTH. GROWING OUT OF
SOCIAL MOVEMENTS IN LATIN AMERICA AND THE GLOBAL SOUTH, THE
SOLIDARITY ECONOMY PROVIDES REAL ALTERNATIVES TO
CAPITALISM, WHERE COMMUNITIES GOVERNMENT EARN THEMSELVES

THROUGH PARTICIPATORY DEMOCRACY, COOPERATIVE, PUBLIC
OWNERSHIP AND CULTURE OF SOLIDARITY AND RESPECT FOR THE
EARTH. IF WE PUT THEM INTO FOCUS POINTS. AND THIS IS A WAY

SUSTAINABILITY. SOCIAL, ECONOMIC DEMOCRACY. PLURALISM AND ORGANIC APPROACH. ALUG FOR DIFFERENT FORMS IN DIFFERENT CONTEXTS AND --

AND THE, THE ADVANCEMENT OF THAT CHANGES IS NECESSARY. AND INEVITABLE. AND A BOTTOM-UP APPROACH. SO, WE BREAK IT DOWN IN KIND OF TAKE EACH ONE OF THESE AND, AND, AND -OFTEN DO ROLE PLAYS ON WHAT THEY MEAN. AND THIS IS WHAT
VOLAR, VILLAGE OF LOVE AND RESISTANCE, RESISTANCE IS TRYING TO DO, RIGHT? WE ARE A COLLECTIVE. WE, WE ARE -BUILDING --

WHICH IS THE PLAN THAT IS FOLK WHOSE ARE SOCIAL JUSTICE ACTIVISTS AND HAVE -- A PRACTICE, SOME SPIRITUAL PRACTICE THAT TPWROUPBDZ THEIR WORK WOULD BE LIVING THERE. AND WILL BE -- DEVELOP, DEVELOPING SOCIAL CONTRACT FOR HOW THAT HAPPENS, WHAT DOES THAT LOOK LIKE. THAT'S, THE HOUSING COMPONENT. OF THE, OF THE SMALLER BUILDING THAT WE OWN. THE -- ECONOMIC ASPECT OF STABILITY AND EVEN DEVELOPMENT, RIGHT? OUR INVESTMENT PLAN IS SUCH THAT A PERSON CAN INVEST FOR AS LITTLE AS \$10 A MONTH AND BECOME A SHAREHOLDER IN CO-OWNING THE PROPERTY. OWNED BY RESIDENTS. DAY CARE, KPHER SAL KITCHEN. EVENT SPACE. DAY CARE WAS DECIDED ON THROUGH A SHARED PROCESS THROUGH THE COMMUNITY AS NUMBER ONE THING. (COMMERCIAL) AND THE COMMERCIAL KITCHEN FOR PEOPLE WHO ARE DOING SMALL CATERING OUT OF THEIR HOUSES. THAT THEY CAN HAVE A SPACE TO GO AND DO LARGER AMOUNTS IF THEY SO CHOOSE. AND, THE EVENT SPACE BECAUSE --

GIVE YOU AN IDEA HOW WE ARE SET UP, AS FAR AS GOVERNANCE.

WE HAVE A BOARD OF DIRECTORS BECAUSE THAT IS REQUIRED FOR

THE FEDERAL -- NONPROFIT STATUS. REALLY, EVERYBODY ON THE

BOARD OF DIRECTORS RIGHT NOW IS ON THE CARE TAKING COUNCIL.

THIS IS THE LEADERSHIP COUNCIL. WHAT REALLY HAPPENS, WHO

DOES THE WORK IS HERE ON THE CARE TAKING COUNCIL. AND THEN

WE HAVE, COMMITTEES -- OF THE ORGANIZATION, WHICH AS YOU

KNOW, IS --

VERY TYPICAL OF MANY ORGANIZATIONS. AND, AND, AND THE COMMITTEE IS REALLY, THE COMMITTEE IS DUE TO WORK ORGANIZING COMMITTEE, THE ORGANIZING SCHOOL, -B BASE BUILDING, OWN OUR HOOD, COOPERATIVE LIVING, FUND-RAISING, ENSOR STREET, GROUP TRYING TO GO ABOUT ACQUIRING THE HOSPITAL NEXT DOOR. AND, AND, FOLKS ON THE COMMITTEE, ARE ON THE CARE TAKING COUNCIL, AND WE HOLD TO, THE WE BUILD LEADERSHIP IS INVITE THE GENERAL MEMBERSHIP TO -- TO WORK ON A COMMITTEE. AND THEN, AFTER WORKING ON A COMMITTEE THAT HAS PEOPLE FROM THE CARE TAKING COUNCIL, FOLKS LEARN ABOUT THE ORGANIZATION, LEARN ABOUT, OR, ETHICS, VALUES, PRACTICE OUR ETHICS, VALUES, AND THEN -- ARE INVITED TO APPLY TO BECOME PART OF THE CARE TAKING COUNCIL. AND OF COURSE, A BOARD OF DIRECTOR, WE DON'T HOLD A LOT OF --WE DON'T BUY INTO THIS WHOLE BOARD OF DIRECTOR THING AS FAR AS IT, SO THIS IS WHY WE REALLY WORK THROUGH THE CARE TAKING COUNCIL. AND SOME OF THE WORK THAT WE DO, SO ONE OF THE THINGS THAT THE SOLIDARITY ECONOMY MODEL DOES IS IT --

POLITICAL EDUCATION, IT IS ABOUT --

MUTUALISM. ALL OF THOSE PRINCIPLES WE TALKED ABOUT. SO, WE ARE REALLY WORKING, LIKE, PRACTICING WITH THE SYSTEMS.

RIGHT? SO, WE CALL IT, MUTUAL AID SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC SYSTEM. WE HAVE A FOOD MUTUAL AID. WHERE WE PROVIDE FOOD TO THE COMMUNITY. ALL OF THE VOLUNTEERS ON THE MUTUAL AID COMMITTEE ARE PEOPLE IN THE COMMUNITY, PEOPLE WHO CAME THROUGH THE LINE SAYING INITIALLY AND THEY REALLY LOOKED WHAT THEY FELT, THAT PEOPLE WEREN'T JUDGING THEM OR LOOKING DOWN ON THEM. AND FOR FOLKS WHO BECOME A VOLUNTEER OF THIS COMMITTEE, THEY GO THROUGH --

AN ORIENTATION WHERE WE PRACTICE NONVIOLENCE. BECAUSE

PEOPLE COMING THROUGH THE LINE ARE PEOPLE WHO, LIKE HAVE

HAD A ROUGH TIME OF IT, RIGHT? AND THE WAY WE, WE TALK WITH

PEOPLE --

IT IS REALLY IMPORTANT --

AND WE HAVE TO BE ABLE TO HOLD WHAT PEOPLE ARE BRINGING IN THAT LINE. SO, THAT, SO THAT WE DON'T LASH OUT TO SOME ONE GRABS FOOD, WHEN WE ASK THEM NOT TO DO THAT. OR SOME ONE DOESN'T WEAR A MASK, WE ASK THEM TO PUT A MASK ON. WE GO THROUGH AN ORIENTATION WITH VOLUNTEERS. WE HAVE A WELLNESS

SPACE. AVENUE QUARTER WE TRY TO DO A WELLNESS EVENT. WHERE FOLKS, WHO HAVE COMMUNITY ACUPUNCTURE. AND DOING YOGA. HEALING IS IMPORTANT. TALK ABOUT TRAUMA. SHOWS UP IN THE BODY AND MIND. THE, THE ORGANIZING SCHOOL DOES THE POLITICAL EDUCATION. DOES THE LEARNING, CIRCLES. WE HAD A GREAT YEAR LAST YEAR. POLITICAL EDUCATION OUTSIDE IN THE YARD. AND MEMBERSHIP IS A BIG THING, HOW WE BUILD MEMBERSHIP, HOW WE BUILD LEADERS. SO WE REALLY TAKE ALL OF THE BIG PRINCIPLES AND WE TRY TO INCORPORATE IT PRACTICALLY, NOT JUST, WRITING ON PAPER, BUT WE TRY TO PRACTICE WITH IT. I WANT TO CLOSE JUST GIVING A QUICK LOOK AT OUR INVESTMENT STRATEGY. THIS IS HOW WE ARE LOOKING TO BUILD THIS COMMUNITY INVESTMENT TRUST FUND. ON THE LEFT —THIS IS HOW —

FOLKS ARE INVESTING IN THE BUILDING. THEY CAN INVEST UP TO \$10 to \$100 a month. We also here, we have national investors, really these are --

BIG INVESTORS OR LOAN PRODUCTS THAT MAY BE NEEDED IN ORDER
TO GET THIS BUILDING RENOVATED. WE REALLY HOPE WE DON'T
HAVE TO. BUT --

COUPLE OF THE MODELS, BASING OURS ON HAD TO ALSO HAD TO DO
THAT. HAVE, HAVE THAT LARGER INVESTOR AMOUNT. AND THEN

MONEY AFTER THE BUILDING IS RENOVATED THAT CONTINUES TO GO
IN AS A REVENUE OR INCOME. ARE THE PEOPLE WHO ARE GOING TO
BE --

IN, OCCUPYING THE SPACE. THEN THE MONEY THAT COMES OUT TO OUR, OUR COMMUNITY INVESTORS, WHAT WE ARE LOOKING AT IS 6% TO 7%. AS YOU KNOW IF YOU DO ANY INVESTMENT, ACTUALLY, IF YOU TRY TO DO A CD, YOU ARE LUCKY IF YOU GET .5%. RIGHT. ON YOUR, ON YOUR INVESTMENT. SAVING ACCOUNT, .05 OR SOMETHING LIKE THAT. WE ARE LOOKING AT 6 TO 7% BACK TO OUR COMMUNITY INVESTORS. WE REALLY FEEL IT IS IMPORTANT TO BE ABLE TO SHOW PEOPLE IF YOU PUT MONEY ASIDE THERE IS SOMETHING THAT COMES FROM IT. NOW WE KNOW, \$10 END OF THE YEAR, EVEN 6 TO 7% ON THAT. WE ARE NOT TALKING BUILDING ASSET OR BUILDING WEALTH. WE ARE REALLY TALKING BUILDING COMMUNITY. STARTING TO THINK ABOUT WHAT, WHAT A SOLIDARITY ECONOMY LOOKS LIKE WHEN PEOPLE COLLECTIVELY COME TOGETHER TO OWN STUFF. WHAT DO THEY DO, HOW DO THEY TAKE MORE PRIDE, HOW DO THEY SEE THIS IS SOMETHING OF VALUE TO THEM? RIGHT. AND THEN OF COURSE, IF WE HAVE THESE NATIONAL INVESTORS WE WON'T BE LOOKING AT MORE THAN 1% BACK ON THAT INVESTMENT. IF THEY'RE LOANS OF COURSE IT IS GOING TO BE MORE THAN 1%. PROBABLY, 3%, 4%. AND THEN -- OF COURSE --

PAYING OUT, WHAT WE NEED -- AS FAR AS OUR UPKEEP,

UTILITIES, ETC. SO WE USE THIS, WE DO THE, THE -- OWNER

TRAINING ON FINANCIAL LITERACY HELP PEOPLE UNDERSTAND. WHAT

THE PROGRAM IS A BOUT. THIS IS OUR TIME LINE. WHERE WE ARE

AT. AS I SAID WE ARE HOPING TO BEGIN APRIL, THAT'S NEXT

MONTH, WITH THE ACTUAL --

RENOVATION OF THE SMALL BUILDING. AND FINISH THAT, SOMETIME IN SEPTEMBER. AND YOU SEE HERE, IT IS A COMPLETION OF 1031, THATS, THE SMALL BUILDING. AND, RENOVATION, BEGIN RENOVATION OF 1025, THE LARGE BUILDING. WE ARE HOPING THAT WE, WE HAVE GOT SCHEMATIC, NOW OF THE LARGE BUILDING. SO I AM HAPPY TO --

HAVE COMMENTS, TAKE QUESTIONS, HEAR YOUR STORY OF --SIMILAR WORK. OR, WORK YOU THINK --

IS BUILDING ON THIS KIND OF, ALTERNATIVE WAY OF, REBUILDING COMMUNITIES. OF JUSTICE. YEAH. OR, OR --

IF OTHERS HAVE ANY OTHER THINGS OR WAYS THEY WANT TO -- USE THE TIME.

>> YES, IF I MAY. THANK YOU VERY MUCH FOR A TRULY INSPIRING PRESENTATION. I HAD ONE OBSERVATION THAT I WANTED TO OFF FOR THE AUDIENCE AND FOR YOU. ASK IF IT IS POSSIBLE FOR YOU AND ME TO EXCHANGE EMAILS. I HAVE SOME THINGS THAT I WANT TO SEND YOU, THAT MIGHT HELP IN THE PROCESS, WRITINGS I HAVE DONE IN TIMES PAST. THE OBSERVATION I WANT TO GIVE YOU, I THINK IF I REMEMBER CORRECTLY, YOU, THE TITLE OF THE TALK, TALKS ABOUT SEPARATION. AND ON ONE OF THE SLIDES IS YOU HAD, FRAGMENTATION. AND, I WANT TO DRAW A DISTINCTION BETWEEN THE TWO. BECAUSE --

FRAGMENTATION IS ACTUALLY VERY GOOD, YOU KNOW WHY? BECAUSE,
THE POWER OF THE TOTALITY OF WHAT IS FRAGMENTED IT IS LOOK
A DNA. IT GOES WITH ALL OF THE PIECES THAT ARE FRAGMENTED.
SO IF ANYBODY THINKS ABOUT, OH, THEY'RE GOING TO FRAGMENT
THE WHOLE AND THEREFORE, QUOTE, UNQUOTE, CONQUER, IT IS NOT
GOING TO BE POSSIBLE. BECAUSE EVERY FRAGMENT MAINTAINS THE
POWER AND THE POTENTIAL OF THE TOTALITY OF IT. SEPARATION
IN MY MIND'S EYE IS WHEN YOU BASICALLY CUT THE UMBILICAL
CORD. AND, AND, I HAVE FOUND IN MY LIFE SO FAR THAT -- AS
TIME MOVES ON, SEPARATION IS BECOMING HARDER AND HARDER
BECAUSE PEOPLE ARE BEGINNING TO REALIZE, ALL OF THAT WHICH
YOU HAVE PRESENTED WHICH IS, WE ARE ALL PART OF THE SAME

CHAIN. AND SO, IF YOU, YOU KNOW, YOU MIGHT AS WELL BE SITTING ON A BRANCH, CUTTING OFF THE BRANCH ON WHICH YOU ARE SITTING. PEOPLE DON'T DO THAT TYPICALLY. FRAGMENTATION, I THINK IS REALLY GOOD. BECAUSE, EVERY SINGLE FRAGMENT MAINTAINS THE POTENTIAL AND TO REALIZE THAT AND, IMAGINE HOW MUCH POWER IS THEN DEVELOPED IN THE COMMUNITY. WE SEE THAT HAPPENING RIGHT NOW IN ISRAEL. PEOPLE GET OUT -- 500,000 PEOPLE IN THE STREETS DEMONSTRATING SAYING, WE ARE POT GOING THAT WAY. WE CAN TAKE A LESSON FROM THAT WAY, FOR OURSELVES. THANK YOU VERY MUCH FOR THIS OPPORTUNITY TO SPEAK.

  HOW IT BECOMES FRAGMENTED, WHERE, WHICH IS WHY I WAS
  TALKING ABOUT COHESION EARLIER. BECAUSE, WHAT WE FIND IN
  COMMUNITIES LIKE, EAST BALTIMORE, THAT HAVE BEEN
  HISTORICALLY OVER AND OVER AGAIN, UPROOTED, AND PLACED IN
  ANOTHER AREA, UPROOTED AND PLACED IS PEOPLE, THE BONDS ARE
  BROKEN. WHEN THOSE BONDS ARE BROKEN, IT'S PEOPLE, IT'S

ALMOST LOOK PEOPLE ARE LOOKING AROUND TRYING TO REMEMBER,
WHAT WAS OVER THERE. THEY, THE PLACES HAVE BEEN COMPLETELY
GENTRIFIED, NO BUILDINGS, PEOPLE FORGET THEIR ADDRESSES
LOCALE, THIS LEAVES PEOPLE BEING DISEMPOWERED. THE WAY I AM

AND STAY TILL THE VERY END. OF HOW THAT HAPPENS. IT IS NOT JUST IN MUTUAL AID AS I WAS SAYING. WE HAVE, LAST NIGHT WE HAD OUR MEMBERSHIP -- MEETING. SO PEOPLE CAME OUT. AND,

AND -- TALKED ABOUT THE COMMITTEES THEY'RE PART OF. AND, HOW THEY WANT TO GET INVOLVED. WE DISCUSS WHAT FINANCING, HOW WE DO FINANCING AND BUDGETING. AND, WHY FUND-RAISING IS SO IMPORTANT. ASK PEOPLE, YOU KNOW, SAY --WHAT'S NEEDED FOR, FOR, AN ORGANIZATION LIKE VOLAR TO BE EFFECTIVE? SO PEOPLE ARE TAKING RESPONSIBILITY. THE WHOLE IDEA OF VOLAR IS TO -- DEVELOP COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP. SO THAT IT IS THE COMMUNITY THAT RUNS THE WHOLE ORGANIZATION. AND THAT'S WHAT, THAT REQUIRES CONTINUED EDUCATION. POLITICAL EDUCATION. LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT. WE ARE HAVING A LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT RETREAT IN --EN JUNE. I THINK, LATE JUNE. WITH CURRENT COMMUNITY MEMBERS WHERE WE JUST --DO A LOT OF WORK AROUND, ORGANIZING WHAT THAT MEANS. POWER ANALYSIS. WHAT THAT MEANS. WHY IT IS IMPORTANT TO DO THIS KIND OF WORK, AND LEARN. THE HISTORY. LEARN ABOUT --POSITIVE MOVEMENTS. SO --

FOLKS ARE VERY --

EXCITED ABOUT -- AN ORGANIZATION. THAT LISTENS, I MEAN THAT ITS WHAT WE HEAR A LOT. VOLAR LISTENS TO PEOPLE. WANTS TO HEAR WHAT PEOPLE THINK. WHAT, WHAT FOLKS WANT TO SEE ON THE LAND. YEAH, WHAT THEY WANT TO SEE IN THE BUILDING. THE FUND-RAISING COMMITTEE WHICH I AM PART OF. WE ARE PLANNING
